01

HOW DO YOU FOWL?

Knock down all of your opponent's pins with a football before they knock down all of yours.

02

WHO GOES FIRST?

The team with the oldest player in the group gets to choose their side and throws first (because we respect our elders). Then the other team gets a turn. If no one wants to reveal their age, flip a coin (it's not polite to ask a lady her age, after all).

03

WHERE DO YOU STAND?

You can stand on either side of the board. Gentlemen have to throw from behind the back of the board and ladies can throw from behind the front edge of the board. Commit a foot fault and any pins knocked down have to be returned to the upright position (like your tray table during takeoff).

04

CAN YOU BLOCK YOUR OPPONENT'S THROW?

No, you cannot, but you can protect your pins from unwieldy throws from neighboring teams (if they knock a pin down it counts).

05

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU ACCIDENTALLY KNOCK DOWN ONE OF YOUR OWN PINS?

That counts as a pin down for your opponent, so don't do that!

06

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU KNOCK DOWN ALL OF YOUR OPPONENT'S PINS AT ONE TIME?

Strike! Your team wins automatically! That's really hard to do, so congratulations on your achievement (come to the front and let us know so we can take your picture!).
