Making the decision to carry a concealed weapon is a decision that should not be taken lightly and that's why our courses are so comprehensive and detailed. When it comes to protecting yourself or your family, you need to know as much as you can so that you are well prepared to defend your loved ones if the situation arises. You should also be aware of the repercussions that could arise from defending yourself and we'll talk about that during our classes. If you defend yourself – make no mistake – you will be arrested. You should consider maintaining a specialized self-defense insurance policy that protects you and covers the expense of attorney's fees, court costs – and pays you while in civil court!!

Here's some additional information regarding our Concealed Carry course

Concealed Carry:

This course fulfills all training requirements for a Florida Concealed Weapon or Firearms License.

Class Length: Approximately 6-8 hours plus range time (*Please note that range fees are NOT included in our costs. Range fees are based on the range that you choose and are paid directly to the range.)

What to bring to class: Receipt (if paid in advance) or payment due (cash or credit card)
Valid State-issued photo ID (must be over 21)

Range time: Range time equipment rentals and range fees are not included. You will need a handgun and at least 20 rounds of ammunition for the range portion that occurs at the end of class. We recommend bringing 50 rounds or more if you would like to practice on the range. You will also need eye and ear protection. Please wear closed toe shoes – NO sandals! Shirts must not be v-necks or tank tops, bring a lightweight button up shirt, if needed.

Booking & Cancellation: Full payment will be due to the instructor at the start of class, cash or credit.

Do **NOT** bring weapons or ammunition into the classroom; they should remain securely locked in your vehicle or cased until we go to the range.

Your CCW Permit is valid for 7 years, costs are mandated by the State of Florida and paid to them. Those costs are in addition to your class fee and range fees. Your Concealed Carry License is not issued in class – you will receive a training certificate after you successfully complete your range time at the end of class, which you must submit with your application before you receive your license.
