Why Hire a Tree Care Professional.

I am sure many of you have had a so called "Tree Guy" or two knock on your door and offer to prune or remove your trees. Please beware of these individuals going door to door, claiming to be arborists and offering bargains for performing tree work. Many of them have no professional tree care credentials and may perform unnecessary work that can be detrimental to your tree's health. They may not even have insurance. Would you hire someone who randomly knocked on your door, claiming to be an electrician, to wire your unfinished basement or an addition you were planning? Most likely not. Driving through Lake Ridge, I have seen many examples of poor tree pruning that ultimately results in tree decline and then removal.



Arborists specialize in the care of individual trees. Hiring an arborist is not a decision that should be taken lightly. Proper tree care is an investment, which provides a substantial return and can add considerable value to your property. Most people spend more money on maintaining their grass than on maintaining their trees and landscaping. This is unfortunate since properly maintained trees often contribute about 15 times more to their property value than well maintained turf. When looking for the right arborist for the job, I suggest checking for membership in professional organizations such as the ISA, the Tree Care Industry Association (TCIA), or ASCA. ISA Certified Arborists and ASCA Registered Consulting Arborists are both experienced professionals who have passed at least one extensive examination covering all

aspects of tree care. Certified Arborists are typically the type of arborist you would hire to do tree pruning, removals, plant health care, or tree planting.
