- Dry Hydrants Testing Jeanne W. reported that the Fire Department Captain has put us on the schedule to have the 2 dry hydrants tested
- Landscaping Mr.. Beers looked at all the different areas and noticed additional landscaping needs i.e. weeding, leaves, tree trimming, etc. We currently have S.Jones, B.Hayes and G & C Landscaping doing different areas. Can we look into seeing if any of them can take on more or do a separate contract with another company to help in these areas? John B. and Ben P. will go around with Scott B. to make a list of areas/items that need work. They can then get a couple of bids to see what the cost might be.

• Dam Liaison - We got notified that our applications were approved but they didn't specify which applications so Larry will check with them. We will need 2 separate inundation studies. A "regular" study for the upper dam and a "simplified" study is needed for the lower dam and can be done by the state. The regular study has to be done by an outside group. Larry has a list of people from the state.

She will look to change out some plants at the front gate with some hardier plants due to the wind.

 - Kick panels for Clubhouse door panels: 8" metal brass/steel/aluminum
 - 4 of the 6" dock posts are cracked and need to be replaced approximate Cost \$2000 all in for 8" replacement posts (George Pierce will be doing the Work-asap weather permitting)

Social Committee: Bill and Carol Bracker - The Sunset on the River Event was a Cabaret Night on Saturday, April 26th, at 5:30 pm. Paul Malloy and Scott McGuire performed.
