1. Pick Your Power Pages

- Tours, itineraries, experiences
- Evergreen guides (e.g., "Best time to visit X")

o FAQs, reviews, cancellation policies

2. Build 11ms.txt

- One URL per line, optionally grouped by theme
- Keep file size < 10 kB for fast parsing

3. Host at Root Domain

- Upload to domain.com/llms.txt
- o Ensure a clean HTTP 200 response

4. Automate Updates

Hook your CMS or scripts to auto-append new content

5. Watch the Lift

- Track Al-generated mentions in tools like ChatGPT, Perplexity, Bing Copilot
- Early adopters report up to a 35% increase in Al-driven traffic
