

Cat Adoption Application

Please complete all information requested.

Thank you for your interest in providing a lifelong home for one of our cats. The completion of this questionnaire is the first step toward what we hope will be many years of happiness for both you and our rescue cat. Once you have answered all the questions, one of our volunteers will review your application and have a few follow-up questions to ask. Please note that we do not respond to incomplete applications.

What happens next depends. We may then:

- Ask for you to wait for I-2 days for vet references and/or rental verifications.
- Ask to schedule a home visit so we can gauge the personality of the pets you have at home.
- Ask to converse with your vet to review your current or previous pet's medical history.
- We do verify health info with your vet.
- Approve your application.

Submitting an adoption application to Fancy Cats and Dogs Rescue Team does not commit the applicant to that adoption nor guarantee adoption approval of the specified or any adoptable cat listed with Fancy Cats and Dogs. We seek the best match of personality, temperament and home environment for our cats and future adoptive families. We are looking out for the best interests of our cats. We realize that some outcomes may be disappointing, please understand that we want the best fit for our cats.

If your application is approved, you will be asked to sign a legally binding contract when adopting your cat. Our adoption fees cover several services including vaccinations and spay/neuter to provide you with a healthy pet.

*We do not adopt kittens singly without another young and/or playful dog or cat at home.

The above totals do not include food, litter, post-operative drugs, or other routine expenses.

All adoption fees go directly towards providing medical care, food, litter and shelter for all of our rescued cats. As shown above, the adoption fees often do not cover the costs of the care we provide each cat.

Once the paperwork is complete and the adoption fee is paid, you can bring your new companion home. You need to provide a carrier for transport. We may contact you after the adoption to follow up and ensure your cat is settling in well.

Conditions of adoption:

- You must have a valid identification showing your current address and your age. You must be at least 21 to adopt.
- If you are renting, we need a copy of your lease showing pets are permitted any required deposits/fees are paid. If you own your home, we do verify home ownership.
- Fancy Cats & Dogs Rescue Team's service area is within a 50-mile radius of Northern Virginia and reserves the right to decline applications outside of the service area.

- You must be able and willing to spend the time and money necessary to provide training, medical treatment and proper care for a cat.
- For the first 30 days, please keep cat separated and confined to one area; you should not expose other animals in the home to this cat until after the initial vet checkup.
- You must be willing to provide a life-long commitment to the care and well-being of your cat. If you cannot make a lifetime commitment (cats can live 15–20 years) to a Fancy Cats and Dogs' cat, please consider adopting from your local shelter whose policies are less stringent than ours.
- Fancy Cats and Dogs Rescue Team does not allow or disallow adoptions based on an individual's race, gender, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, age or disability.
