As more and more groups of people were thrust into grieving they became enraged and began unbelieving.




Little by little, the people of the land realized the new leaders were inhumane --- that their country had been handed over to fast-talking terminators who didn't care about others, only about themselves.

The people had elected them because they had grown weary of governments funding wars and subsidizing industries -- the entire economy was built off their backs!


The people were looking for real solutions-- not baits, clever marketers, empty promises, and more fancy plans.
