Blue Ridge Equestrian, LLC agrees to furnish fresh cooled semen (if available—otherwise, frozen semen will be used) to breed Owner's Mare described below:

This Agreement will be held to the following terms:

- 1.) The Mare's Veterinarian must verify the health of the Mare to Blue Ridge Equestrian, LLC (Referred to further as Blue Ridge). The fully completed Health Form attached to this Contract, must be Signed by the Mare's Veterinarian and include the Mare's Vaccination dates, breeding soundness verification, health history, and prior foaling

history. The Veterinarians Verification and Contract should both be returned to Marsha Ball (Blue Ridge) before this agreement will be signed and considered in effect.

I agree to the following terms of this contract:

- 2.) I agree to pay the Stud Fee of \$2,000.00 for Frozen Semen; \$2,250.00 for Fresh Semen, upon execution of this contract. If Fresh Semen is to be used, there will be a \$250.00 fee to bring stallion to clinic for collection of fresh semen as he is not on site. Checks should be made to Marsha Ball and returned with the signed contract to:

The stud Fee must be received by Blue Ridge before the semen will be shipped. If Fees are not paid in full, (ei. Nonsufficient Funds, etc.) foal will not be allowed to be registered with any entity for performance or sale.

- 3.) In addition to the stud fee, the Mare Owner is responsible for the cost of semen collection, the semen shipping process – including any shipping costs and canister deposit and costs. Mare Owner is to make arrangements for billing and payments with the veterinarian collecting the semen at Idaho Equine Hospital in Nampa, Id. Clinic and Contact person phone number is: (208) 466-4613, Wendy Olson. They need to have your request no later than one day before shipping, by 4:00 PM and confirmed by 9:00 AM on the day of shipping.
- 4.) Mare owner is responsible for all fees accrued by the veterinarian performing the insemination.
- 5.) The Mare Owner is fully responsible for ensuring that the DELIVERY CERTIFICATE included with each semen shipment, by the carrier, is properly filled out by the veterinarian doing the insemination and returning it to Blue Ridge after each cycle.
- 6.) Mare Owner recognizes, authorizes and agrees that should the Sire be unavailable on the date that the semen is requested, frozen semen will be made available to the Mare Owner as a substitute. Idaho Equine Hospital will bill Mare Owner applicable fees. It is the sole responsibility of

the Mare Owner to stay in contact with Idaho Equine Hospital – Liz Scott, DVM – (208) 899-2359 -- regarding availability of semen under this provision. In this case, the shipping and container costs will be billed through Idaho Equine Hospital.

- 7.) It will be the sole responsibility of the Mare Owner to keep the Mare in good health throughout the pregnancy. The Mare's veterinarian will have requirements for vaccinations, worming and check-ups that need to be followed.
- 8.) Should the Mare abort or the foal fail to stand and nurse during the first 24 hours after birth, the Mare Owner will inform Blue Ridge in writing within 10 days. In either situation, Blue Ridge agrees to rebreed Mare, as soon as the Mare is fit, **one (1) additional time only**. Blue Ridge will not, in any event, be required to extend this contract beyond 2 years from the execution of date of this contract.
- 9.) Mare Owner will have a licensed veterinarian certify the pregnancy status of the Mare within 90 days of the last breeding. The veterinarian will fill out the Mare Pregnancy Certificate and return the certification to Blue Ridge upon completion.
- 10.) Should the Mare die or become unfit for breeding because of conditions other than neglect, Blue Ridge, at their discretion, may elect to allow a substitute Mare. This choice by Blue Ridge must be in writing.
- 11.) Should Blue Ridge's Sire die, become unfit, or be sold, this contract will be automatically annulled.
- 12.) Once semen has been shipped from Idaho Equine to Mare Owner, the entire breeding fee has been expended for the purpose of this agreement.
- 13.) Mare Owner is fully responsible for the condition of the Mare and will accept all risk of damage or loss to/of the Mare; whether by sickness, infection, disease, injury, accident, death or otherwise, and by any cause whatsoever. Mare Owner agrees to hold harmless Stallion Owner, Blue Ridge, and any person employed by or associated with Blue Ridge and/or agents or family of Blue Ridge harmless for any and all damages associated herewith.
- 14.) This contract is not transferable.

15.) If any disagreements arise concerning the performance of this Contract, this Contract will be instantly terminated, and the dispute will be deferred to three (3) arbitrators. Each of the undersigned will choose their own arbitrator. The two chosen arbitrators will then, together choose the third arbitrator. The determination of arbitrators will be binding and final. The arbitrators will determine a reasonable amount to cover attorneys' fees and costs to be rewarded to the prevailing party of the dispute.

16.) This Contract/Agreement will be governed by the laws in the state of Idaho. Venue and jurisdiction for any dispute will be in Bonneville County, Idaho.

NOTICE: THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE THAT THIS AGREEMENT/CONTRACT WILL AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATE AND EXPIRE TWO (2) YEARS AFTER THE EXECUTION DATE OF THIS AGREEMENT/CONTRACT.
