Judging will be based on neatness of presentation, content, grammar and originality of presentation. Four categories of competition remain in this years judging based on the size of the club as of October 1, 2018.

CATEGORY 1 ------ Clubs with up to 25 members CATEGORY II ------ Clubs with 26 to 50 members CATEGORY III ------ Clubs with 51 to 74 members CATEGORY IV ------ Clubs with 75 or more members

First, second and third place awards will be chosen for each category.

- 1. The club bulletins or newsletters will be judged at the District Convention. Each club entering the competition should submit all of their bulletins printed to date. A club must enter at least 9 issues of their newsletter to be eligible for the competition.
- 2. Publication dates must be between October 1, 2018 and August 9, 2019.
- 3. Bulletins should be placed in a folder with the following information on a label attached to the front cover.
 - a. Name of the club
 - b. The number of club members as of October 1, 2018
 - c. Category
 - d. The town or community in which the club is located

- 5. Bulletin entries must be turned in at the District Convention registration desk by 10:00 am on Saturday, August 10, 2019.
