Craig Eisenbeise, School Resource Officer and DARE Officer for McGrath, Mark Twain, and St Mary Magdalen reported there were 75 5th graders this past school year completing the DARE program. The program last 10 weeks and was able to

complete 13 modules. As the school resource officer sees many changes taking place. To get into the school there will be a buzzer to get access inside the building. When entry is gained another locked door is in place to allow the receptionist to check identification and issue a visitor's pass. Students will be permitted lunches only in the cafeteria, no longer permitted to go off campus for lunch. Cameras will be installed throughout the building to monitor school. We welcome the new School Resource and DARE Officer, Amon Figgs. He will be attending DARE training in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for two weeks in July. Craig Eisenbeise served the DARE program for 5 years teaching both the 5th and 7th graders. When he was assigned as the School Resource Officer the 7th grade class was discontinued. Mary Meers presented a \$1000.00 donation from our club to offset the expenses for the 2019-2020 school year.

OLD BUSINESS:

Hensley is donating the trailer used by us during the tree lot. The new owner, Anne Corti, has granted permission to park this trailer on the property of the old Brentwood Lanes this year only since the building will be under construction probably after January. We will need to repaint the trailer removing the Hensley naming. After the tree lot we will need to review the removal of electric service to the site our electric box is on and possibly scrap or donate the trailer since the lot will not be available for future tree lots.
