Optimist Club Of Kampala, Gladly carried out its first project in Nanfuka Zone 2. This Slum village exposes one of the worst living conditions ever. It's found in Lubaga division, Nateete Parish located on the southwestern edge of the city of Kampala. The distance from the area to Kampala Capital city is approximately 8 kilometres (5.0 miles). For a reason above average, most of the families in this area are led by Single mothers who are reported not to have serious work employments, where as most are engaged in side hawker businesses to afford for their survival at a Household level. With the Outbreak of the world pandemic (Covid-19), Effects of the lockdown worsened the dwellers living conditions to date, hence justifying the need for OPTIMIST CLUB OF KAMPALA to extend a sharing hand with the Nanfuka village dwellers.
