Quarterly Qualifiers (Needed to Collect Points) Governor Elect will be responsible for verifying eligibility.

1st - Club Verifies Club Officer Contact information with A&A Administrator at emo.aa.ad@gmail.com by Dec 31st or by completing this online form by [CLICKING HERE](#)

2nd - Club Officers (Current) Complete their specified Optimist Institute course by Mar 31st

***If they do this as Officer-elects, they will qualify for this during their "in office" year.

3rd - Club Officer-Elect Report submitted by May 20th

4th - Club Pride Report submitted by Sep 30th

NOTE: There will be a 10-day grace period each quarter to allow members/clubs to report end of quarter projects/activities. For Optimist Year 2022-2023 the deadlines will be January 10, 2023, April 10, 2023, July 10, 2023, and October 10, 2023. No reports will be accepted after these dates.

General Rules

1. Events cannot be used multiple times to collect points for different line items. 1 Event = 1 Line item for points collected. NO DOUBLE DIPPING!!
2. Club must be "In good standing" as described by Optimist International Bylaws to receive ANY District Award or Recognition (points can still be gained and accumulated)
3. Each Quarter, Clubs must complete a qualifier to receive points. Each Quarter's qualifier is different and coordinates with Optimist-related items. (No points are given for the qualifier being completed, however, NO points earned in that quarter will be counted if the qualifier is not completed)
4. Clubs will be recognized for their A&A accomplishments in the following manner:
1st Quarter points recognized at 2nd Quarter Meeting
2nd Quarter points recognized at 3rd Quarter Meeting
3rd Quarter points recognized at 4th Quarter Convention
4th Quarter points & Total Yearly points at 1st Quarter Meeting
5. Clubs will be recognized that earn the following points:

Bronze Level = 250 – 499pts (per Qtr)

Silver Level = 500 – 749pts (per Qtr)

Gold Level = 750 – 999pts (per Qtr)

Platinum Level = 1000+pts (per Qtr)

Bronze Level = 1000 – 1999pts (per Year)

Silver Level = 2000 – 2999pts (per Year)

Gold Level = 3000 – 3999pts (per Year)

Platinum Level = 4000+pts (per Year)

6. Members will receive a ribbon to wear on their name badge at the Quarterly Conferences/ Convention that corresponds to the level reached by their Club each quarter. *Members must be present at the quarterly meeting to receive a ribbon.
7. Clubs will earn 2 FREE registrations to the next Quarter's District Conference/Convention by achieving Platinum Level in one quarter.
8. 2 Free registrations to the next Quarter's District Conference/Convention will be determined by raffle. The number of tickets will be determined as follows:

For EACH Club member present at the Conference/Convention

1 – Bronze Level

2 – Silver Level

3 – Gold Level

Two raffle tickets will be drawn. Each winning ticket represents One Free Registration Fee (Must be used at the very next District Conference/Convention)

***** Free Registrations are to be used on NON-Club Officers Only!!!*****

9. The Clubs receiving the Top 3 Yearly Total Amounts will be asked to create a presentation no longer than 5 minutes in length to be delivered/shown at the 1st Quarter Conference. After all 3 presentations have been seen at the Governor's discretion, the Club with the Most Total Yearly Points will be awarded a Club Banner Patch indicating they were the top Point earning Club, the Optimist Year in which they earned the title & the total number of points earned.
(It will be the responsibility of the Awards & Achievements Committee (of the award year) to design, order, and obtain the Banner Patch to be presented at the 1st Quarter Conference following their administrative year.
10. After completion of online A&A Google form the sender will receive an email acknowledgement confirming receipt of the report from emo.aa.ad@gmail.com Upon review, the A&A Administrator will send email to accept or decline the report. Should the report be declined, the reason will be stated.
11. The Awards & Achievements Committee in coordination with the Governor-Elect will review this program each year. They will make recommendations to the East Missouri Board of Directors at the Annual 4th Quarter Convention to be implemented starting October 1st of each year. (While Board Approval is not necessary per the policies of the East Missouri District, it is recommended that changes receive this approval for transparency & member engagement)
