Each year the club has conducted Optimist International Projects that provided a variety of opportunities for the youth in the Jackson community. These OI projects included: *Essay Contest, Oratorical Contest, Respect for Law, Youth in Government Day, Youth Appreciation Day, and Bicycle Safety.* 

In addition to the OI projects, the club funded several capital projects through the years. Some of those projects were:

- Bicycle Safety Area was built 1992. Major updates and improvements done in 2020-2021.

- Donated \$12,000 for basketball goals at the new Jackson Civic Center (Founding Donor)

- Numerous donations for soccer fields and football fields for youth sports. (JAYF and JAOSA).
- Donated \$5,000 to the SEMO Pickleball Club in 2021 to build pickleball courts at the old tennis courts in Litz Park.
