

Paula Givens, Debra Hoffmann, Lauri Spain and Dorothy Rowley represented our club at the conference. Dorothy attended a special session—"Catch a Rising Star" on Friday evening.

There were several topics presented by members of EMO District as well as from other Optimist districts.

Notes from Governor Liz Christman

- New Member Orientation Program for the district. They are looking for volunteers to help implement this program.
- A committee is being formed to look at ways to help clubs that are financially struggling. She is looking for volunteers to serve on this committee.
- LMS (Learning Management System). Club Presidents, Secretary/Treasurers and Club Foundation Reps are required to complete the training for their specific office by March 31, 2021 in order to be eligible for OI Club awards. OI provides these officers a free registration.
 - Other courses and media library is also available for anyone who has registered for the program. Cost for members to join is \$6 per member.
- Musical Happiness—a new program presented by Optimist International designed to encourage and celebrate youth musical and vocal categories. Youth ages 11-18 are eligible to enter the competition. The participants create an original musical performance in the form of a video posted to You Tube. Video must be 3 minutes or less.

- JOI Around the World—Melanie Gluck and her daughter, Maya, talked about a new JOI club that Maya started. It is a virtual Junior Optimist Club open to youth ages 10-19 from all nations throughout the world. They hold weekly Zoom meetings.
