Nicole Humphreys is a graduate of Jackson High School and a Southeast Missouri State University Athlete. She earned United States Track and Field and Cross Country Association All-Academic recognition. In 2022 she was OVC Female Cofield Athlete of the Year. She is a Silver medalist in the Hammer throw, Bronze medalist in the Shotput and received Fourth Place in the Discus. She accomplished all this while maintaining a 4.0 GPA obtaining her Master's in Business Administration.

Nicole's presentation to the group provided an insight to what it takes to be an athlete at the college level, the hours of practice, dedication, determination, along with the physical and mental requirements. For example after two hours of weight lifting she then would have four hours of practice, not to mention the hours of classwork and her part-time job. She also explained the different techniques of throwing the hammer, discus, and shot-put.

She showed videos of her in action throwing the discus, shot-put, and the hammer. She also showed a video of her teammate, Logan Blomquist who is a National Champ Hammer thrower. He is currently working on making his way to the Olympic trials.

She will graduate in the spring with her Master's and has taken a position in St. Louis and will be moving at the end of the month.
