A COMMON GOAL

In a bulletin article about a year ago we spoke about the synergy we've created with our parish organizations as well as outside agencies and clubs such as the South Side Optimists. Since that original connection, the Optimists have donated around \$2,500 in cash, fuel cards and pantry items. Some of these donations were from the organization, while others came directly from its members. Recently the Optimists really outdid themselves. They began to focus on our St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry for what they call a 5th Wednesday activity.

At one of their regular meetings, they learned that we were creating a new healthy food section, so they kicked things off with a check for \$300 in "seed" money for the project. Then we got word that members wanted to gather groceries and deliver them directly to our pantry. A team of SVDP members met the Optimists at the rectory and helped get the food into the pantry. Many of the members who dropped off food that day we had never met before. They showed up with trucks and vans and cars full of food. The Optimists donated hundreds of dollars' worth of groceries that day.

The more we strengthen the connections with the Optimists, the more we see the shared mission and goals between the two groups. They function much like St. Vincent de Paul, too. The Optimists have a group of dedicated people who run the business at the meetings. They also have a large group of members who show up to do the project work, such as delivering dictionaries to schools, food to pantries, fill the annual Holiday Food Baskets for the needy, and working at the fundraisers. Of course, there is a core group that does both. There is a group within St. Vincent de Paul who helps the Optimists with their work as well.

Another similarity of purpose is the way both St. Vincent de Paul and the ptimj. Sts work with junior groups of students. In both cases, older members are trying to instill in younger members that sense of charitable giving of time and resources to the less fortunate. There are certainly wonderful role models for this work within both groups.

The St. Vincent de Paul pantry at St. Joan of Arc has never been so well stocked and complete asit is now, thanks to our generous parish donors and our partners at the South Side Optimists Club. We are very grateful for the hard work and donations of both groups because that's what allows us to do the work that we do.

As it says in the Optimists' mission statement, "Although we come from all walks of life, we share one common trait. We know we can make a difference in the lives of others ..."


