Executive Director Tracy Smith from Jefferson County Community Partnership was our guest speaker at the February 17th meeting. Jefferson County Community Partnership (JCCP) was formed in 1994 with the purpose of creating partnerships between civic organizations, churches, businesses, and government agencies.

The agency works with Jefferson County residents to provide health and safety programs.

Currently the agency focuses on five programs:

The Parenting Network - Learn parenting skills that are important for a child's success.

Safe Babies - Provides a Pack n' Play and Safe Sleep Kit for infants.

Diaper Bank - Provides diapers every month for low-income families.

Period Supplies - Low-income families can request a period supply kit, consisting of tampons, pads, and pat-liners.

Hammers of Hope - This program engages volunteers to help build accessibility ramps and perform home repairs to the homes of qualifying low-income, elderly, and homeowners with a disability in Jefferson County.
