Paving: Voelker was present to have his bid read for the road repairs in the Borough. Council President Nick Vaccarello presented all of the bids for the road work: they were as follows, G. Mary Harmon also wanted to inform Council that 10 families live on Harmon Lane and there is a pothole problem. Gus told her that they will be repaired soon. Bill White was present to inquire about a sewer tap, not paid for yet, but he wants to know when he can hook up to it. There is to be a meeting with Floyd Himes from the DEP in 1 to 2 weeks and we may have an answer for him then. Mrs. White was present to inquire about the Borough Code Book and was informed that one was in the Library and was available for her to review.

Police Reports were presented by Mayor Butler with 24 hours worked and 47 miles patrolled. There were 4 complaints, 1 barking dog (spoke to the owner), 1 for burning (spoke to the offender), 1 for trash (spoke with complainant) and 1 drive off at the Kwik Fill. Chief Tatton also told Council that the Police Car needs some repairs that would cost about \$187.40. Council gave Chief Tatton the okay for the repairs. Also an ad will be placed in the Butler Eagle for a part time Police Officer until June 30th.

Streets: Paving Bids were referred to Council. Nick Vaccarello reported there is still a 10 thousand dollar limit for the Monroe Street storm sewer project. R. Hixson is filling in holes and cracks on the Borough Streets. Also, Nick Vaccarello will ask Penn Dot to clean 488.

Sewage: Discussion about Business versus Residental rate of billing Council decided to continue the present process of billing.

Personnel: See Police Report.

Maintenance of Facility: Weeds at the Borough Office will be taken care of in the near future.

Library: The Library report was read by Nick Vaccarello.

Planning Commission: Nothing to Report

Mayor: Nothing to Report.

Old Business: Council thanked Mary Harmon for her 8 years of doing the parades. She has a replacement to take charge next year but will still help. State Pipe was contacted about prices of pipe for the Monroe Street project.

Communications: Reviewed several letters and the Jan 2003-Dec 2005 Audit of the Pa Volunteer Fire Dept. Relief Association, a copy will be given to the Library.

New Business: Reviewed the Building Permits issued.

Motion was made by Teddy Davis and seconded by Rita Vaccarello to pay the bills from the Sewage Fund and all present unanimously voted yes. Motion was made by Teddy Davis and seconded by Doug Trimble to pay the Olsen bills and all present voted yes.
