Dean Convery was present to state that he would like to rent his garage out as an apartment. The property was originally approved as a Pizza Shop and Office Space. Alan Vagasky and told him to read chapter 22 and 27 and get all the necessary drawing and present them to the Planning Commission for approval.

Sewage Ed Robinson reported that the Meadville meeting with DEP went really well. Christine Nagy will have a price for the Borough for the overflows in the near future. The meeting with the Park went very well and the information from it will be presented at the next Sewage meeting. The DEP needs our Corrective Action Plan. Also NIRA gave Council a schedule for the Equalization Tank. Motion was made by Ed Robinson and seconded by Glen Gitzen to contact NIRA about the schedule. Jon Hiser will check into who does Grants and will present it at the next Council Meeting. Motion was made by Ed Robinson and seconded by Bob Boice to start the project with the clay dykes and to not have it go over the \$6500.00 all present voted yes.
