GATES SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FY 2020-2021 BUDGET

Program Description:

The Gates Special Improvement District was created by the order of the Bexar County Commissioners Court under the authority of Article III, Sections 52 and 52a of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 382 of the Local Government Code. The purpose of the district is to enter into economic development or grant agreements with developers within the district to induce the developer to construct housing developments as well as supporting infrastructure and to provide land and construct facilities for conservation, parks, recreation and open space within the district. To accomplish the purpose of the district, the district may levy an ad valorem tax not to exceed \$0.55.872 per \$100 valuation, a Sales and Use Tax of 2 percent of each retail sale subject to the state sales and use tax. On May 2, 2020, an election was held authorizing the creation of the district, the levy of taxes, the creation of economic development or grant agreements, and the issuance of bonds and the levy of taxes to pay those bonds.
