What is Comprehensive Community Planning?

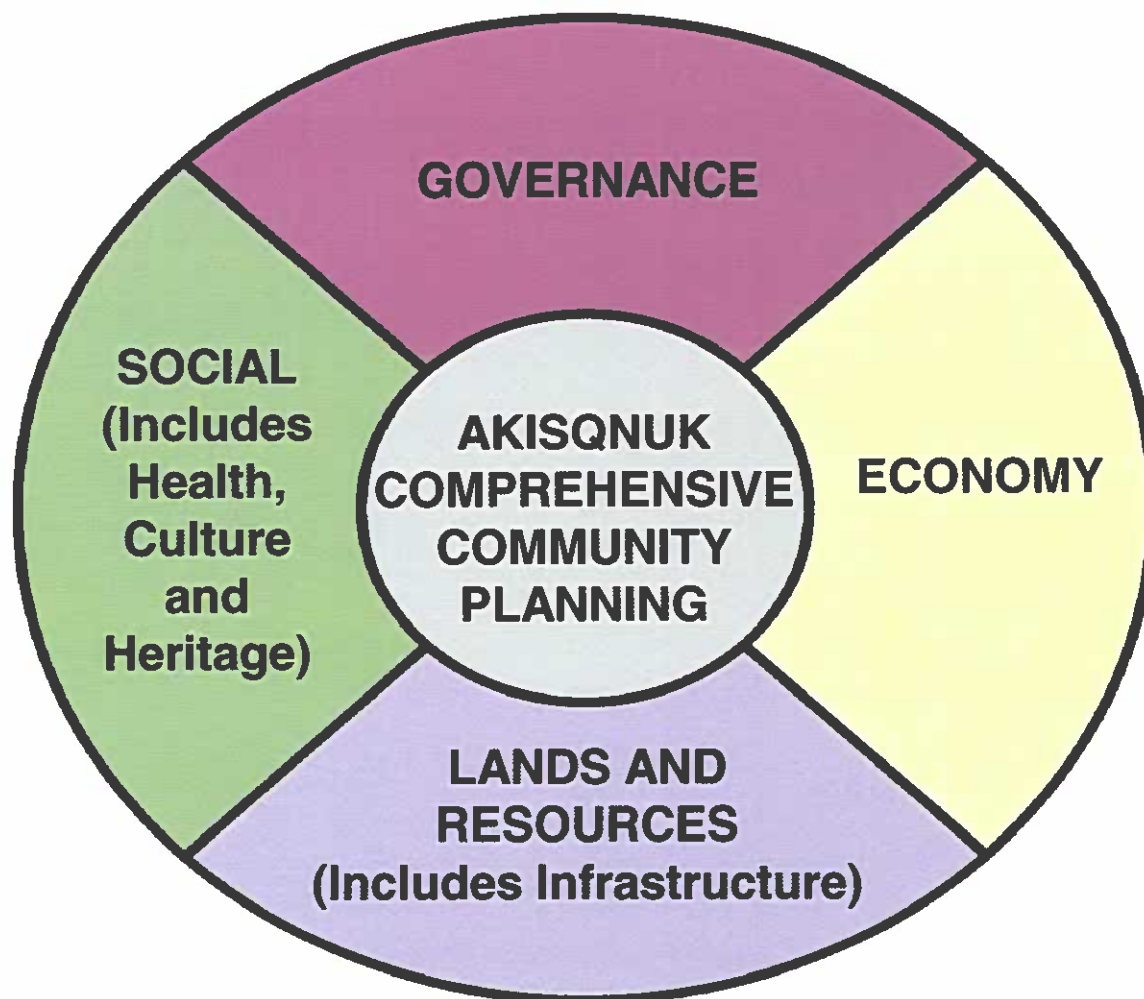
- Comprehensive Community Planning is a balanced approach strategy that enables a community to build towards sustainability, self-sufficiency and improved governance.
- It is a resourceful tool that engages the whole community in the planning process, rather than a committee or small group. Many First Nations communities throughout Canada are currently participating in the planning process and have experienced great success.

Vision: To Become a Healthier Community

- **EMOTIONALLY**
Continue to provide integrated support services
- **MENTALLY**
Provide on going health education
- **SPIRITUALLY**
Create opportunities for spiritual learning

Goal #1

Deliver Effective Health Services

Action:

- Develop Child and Family Services that provides: pre-natal and post-natal programs; life-skills training to parents; and coordinate family celebrations connecting with Children in Care
- Hire an Addictions Worker to educate and communicate on drug problem
- Hire a Youth Worker to administer programs for youth and represent on Council

Goal #2

Increase Health Information and Programs

Action:

- Conduct needs assessment on additional resources and information that needs to be available at the Learning Centre
- Set up nutrition plan for clients

Goal #1 Create Businesses

- Action:**
- Support Entrepreneurs
 - Selectively pursue developable parcels of land for designation to attract/create businesses

- Designate land for the purposes of attracting investors
 - Review, Update, and Implement Recommended Action Plan found in Section 3 of the Community Economic Development and Tourism Strategy Action Plan

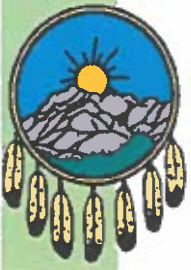

Goal #1 Construction of New Housing

- Action:**
- Provide/support housing for singles and young couples in the form of duplexes
 - Renovate elders homes to incorporate singles into basement suites by accessing renovation funding

Goal #2 Identify Location for Future Subdivision Development

- Action:**
- Develop a proposal for submission to INAC for feasibility study to investigate future location of subdivision

Housing (cont...)

Goal #3 Address Housing Arrears

- Action:**
- Establish Housing Committee by holding a meeting to recruit volunteers including one representative from Chief and Council
 - Develop Terms of Reference
 - Review current housing policies and procedures and process

Goal #4 I.R.#3 Property Assessment

- Action:**
- Request proposals from surveyors to have all lots surveyed including all infrastructure

Goal #1 Support Elementary School Students

- Action:**
- Hire Youth Worker to facilitate and coordinate homework sessions
 - Establish a Role Model program to have students mentored by Ktunaxa Nation members who have engaged in post secondary courses
 - Celebrations (beginning of school year and end of school year) by inviting motivational speakers, principles, etc.

Goal #2

Develop Adult and Elders Education Programming

Action:

- Partner with School District and expand partnership with College of the Rockies to promote post secondary education opportunities
- Submit proposals for adult literacy programs

Education (cont...)

Goal #3 Improve High School Graduation Rates

- Action:**
- Education coordinator/worker to work with parents to do the following:
 - make parents aware of child attendance records
 - make parents aware of child struggles
 - keep lines of communication open

- Action:**
- Develop a Terms of Reference for establishing a Cultural Committee
 - Offer after school culture and craft program offer language lessons to adolescents and adults on a weekly basis
 - Provide community events that are centered on Ktunaxa language

Goal #2 Develop a Ktunaxa Ancestry Tree for Akisqnuk Community

- Action:**
- Develop a Terms of Reference for establishing a Cultural Committee
 - Work with families/ provide opportunity for families to bring forward pictures (past and present)
 - Scan pictures into computer for digital version

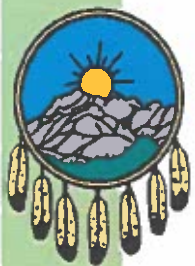

Goal#3 **Develop and Supply Language and Songs to CD, DVD, and Books**

- Action:**
- Develop a Terms of Reference for establishing a Cultural Committee
 - Investigate other communities and KNC library for resources
 - Identify funding sources to cover costs of:
 - developing and reproducing CD's and DVD's;
 - acquiring infant and toddler curriculum resources
 - Acquire phrasebook and resources for workplace use

Goal #1 **Upgrade North Area Water System**

Action: Submit proposal to INAC to approve and fund a feasibility study to bring the current water system to current Health Canada standards



Lands & Resources Sector Infrastructure (cont...)

Goal #2 Develop New Recreational Complex

- Action:**
- Review previous work
 - Acquire funding to undertake a feasibility study/ master plan to select location, uses, servicing requirements, partnership opportunities, and space requirements to identify capital and operation and maintenance costs
 - Identify capital funding sources through development of Business Plan
 - Link and coordinate with final agreement negotiations and funding from BC and Canada to build a new Recreational Complex

Goal #3 Servicing for New Subdivision

Action: Submit proposal to INAC for capital funding

Goal#4 Improve Internet Services

Action: Contact internet service providers to access
availability on reserve

Infrastructure (cont...)

Goal #5 Maintain Clean Drinking Water

Action:

- Maintain building and equipment to current standards
- Encourage members to receive their Level 2 Water System Operator certification as well as water distribution training (flush water lines and hydrants)
- Develop annual training plan to recruit 2-3 people for shift safety
- Expand water quality testing to include groundwater wells on CP and leasehold properties

Goal#1 Protect Important Natural Resources

- Action:**
- Lands Manager to work with local, regional, provincial, and federal governments and organizations to protect water, timber, wildlife, and minerals such as sand and gravel
 - Lands Manager to continue to investigate access to Windermere Creek water resources that belong to the AFN



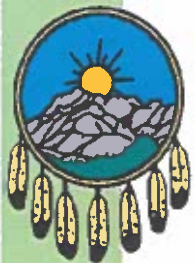

Land Use Planning (cont...)

Goal#2 **Protect over 40 sites/areas on and off reserve**

Action:

- Lands Manager to initiate discussions with Provincial Government to protect off reserve sites
- Lands Manager to designate “Naked Sands” for community use

Goal#3 Taxation for Community Benefit

Action: Develop a committee to engage the community to determine where monies should go

Goal #4 Resolve Estate of Lands

Action: • Provide information and assistance on preparing a legal Will
