Externally, we are here to serve the Community, and internally, we are our own Community, comprised of different departments unified by our Vision, Mission, and Values. As a team, through our own roles and departments, the ʔAFN Organization works together to achieve our strategic plan "Our Thinking" and continue to progress and move our community forward.

Note: We are looking for 4 staff (both full-time and part-time) for 6 months.

The primary responsibilities include:

- Perform routine maintenance tasks such as mowing lawns, trimming bushes, and cleaning public areas.
- Inspect facilities and equipment for safety and functionality.
- Repair or report any damages to facilities, equipment, or infrastructure.
- Maintain cleanliness of campsites, facilities and grounds.
