About the Koby Sevens Tournament

The Champion Grads RFC have a longstanding tradition of hosting a Sevens tournament on the Mother's Day Weekend. Formerly known as the Ryback Sevens in honour of Mike Ryback, the Koby Sevens tournament has been renamed in memory of Paul 'Koby' Kobayashi. We will continue to honour the memory of Mike Ryback by awarding the Ryback Trophy to the winning team.

The Koby Sevens is a two-day tournament taking place May 10 - 11 at the Regina Rugby Club. The tournament will feature senior men's and women's teams competing for cash prizes. This year we will also host U20 Men's and U18 Women's divisions with teams from three provinces competing as they prepare for the Canada Summer Games.

The tournament will start at 11:30 am on Saturday. A cabaret with live entertainment will take place Saturday night at the Rugby Club. Final games will take place Sunday.

Senior Men's Division
