## Care © Handling for Acrylic supplies

Keep your paint it in a cool place. Do not leave in the car, sun or baking near a sunny window. KEEP it from FREEZING by leaving outside in a cold climate.

Only use cool water to wash your brushes.
First wipe off excess paint to keep it out of pipes and $t$ the ocean. Then rinse in cool water. Rub brush on a bar of handsoap and rinse until no color comes off on a rag or papertowel. Hot water dissolves the glue that holds the bristles in, so remember to keep it cool!


Using a palette knife instead of a brush will extend the life of your brushes AND create a better batch of paint to use.

Find out more about how to use additives and media in my Acrylic Painting courses. Gesso is good to use first if you use uncoated paper.
