Inspired by the words of Swami Vivekananda — “If the poor boy cannot come to education, education must go to him” — we are committed to bringing education to



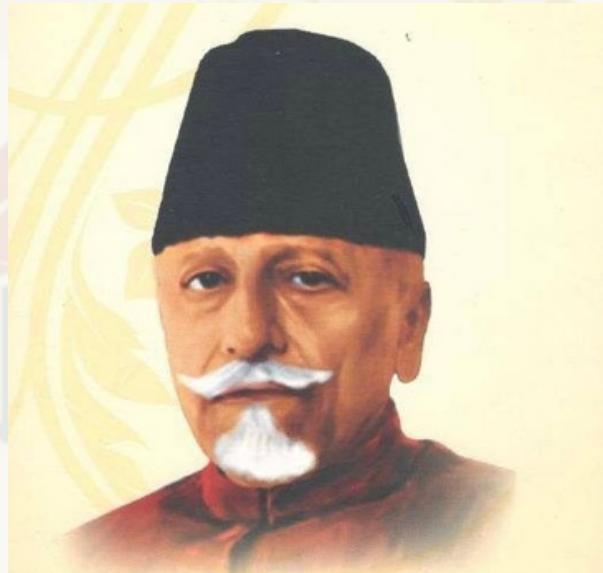

Kalam Ghulam Muhiyuddin, widely known as Maulana Azad, was a distinguished scholar, writer, and a prominent freedom fighter who also became Independent India's first Education Minister. In recognition of his immense contributions, he was posthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna, the country's highest

civilian honor, in 1992. A man of great principles, Maulana Azad lived a life marked by simplicity, discipline, and dedication. As one of the founding figures of Jamia Millia Islamia, he played a pivotal role in shaping and strengthening this esteemed institution, particularly during its formative years. His profound knowledge, sharp intellect, and forward-

looking vision made him a true pioneer who was far ahead of his time. Maulana Azad strongly advocated for religious harmony, secularism, brotherhood, social justice, and the upliftment of marginalized communities. He was instrumental in the establishment of Jamia Millia Islamia in Delhi as well as several Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) across the country.

Our institute draws inspiration from his progressive ideals and is therefore proudly named in his honor.



ABOUT OUR INSTITUTION

MAFEC Delhi was established by Raghiv Naushad (a practicing advocate and alumnus of the Faculty of Law, Jamia Millia Islamia) on 22nd February 2020, coinciding with the death anniversary of Maulana Azad. The institute was founded with the vision of providing free and quality education to underprivileged students who lack access to proper study



materials and resources required to excel in various law entrance examinations. To fulfill this mission, the Maulana Azad Free Education Centre began offering free coaching and guidance to selected students preparing for CUET, Jamia BA LLB, AMU Law, MHCET, and other law entrance exams across India.

Alongside the Free Super-30 Batch, we also introduced a Self-Finance Batch, where students are admitted at a nominal fee of ₹9,999, with no seat limit. Admission to the Super-30 Batch is strictly merit-based and conducted through an online entrance test.

Since its inception in 2020, MAFEC has proudly achieved 500+ selections in various courses at prestigious universities from previous batches (2020–2025).

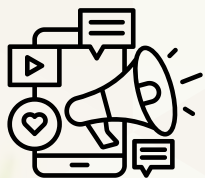
