Brut Rosé Reserve, Loimer Niederösterreich NV 85

Notes of fresh strawberries and cherries accented by sweet herbs and flowers.

Champagne Brut - Cuvée Leonie, Canard Duchene, NV 100

White fruits and a light citrus are easy and ready to drink

Champagne Brut, Veuve Clicquot, NV 120

Beautiful ripe fruit, poached pear, grated ginger, and light cream

Champagne Brut Rosé, Billecart-Salmon NV 165

Strawberries, orange peel and hints of cream and pie crust

Champagne Brut - Belle Epoque, Perrier-Jouët, 2014 320

Subtle hints of apple green, fresh and delicate, with distinctive aromas of white fruit and flowers

Champagne Brut Rosé - Belle Epoque Perrier-Jouët, 2013 500

Medium bodied with never ending bubbles, flavors of red berries, orange, toast, red apples, and notes of pink grapefruit.

Hampton Water, Languedoc Rosé, 2021 75

Candied fruit of red currents with great balance.

Minuty Rosé, Château Minuty, Côtes de Provence, 2021 65

Tangy berries to tropical fruit notes; it's vibrant on the palate with refreshing zesty and herbaceous notes

Sancerre Rosé, l'Authentique, Claude & Florence Thomas Labaille, Loire, 2022 85

Notes of red currents, grapefruit and mineral with a fresh finish.

sweet(ish)

Auslese Cuvée, Kracher, Burgenland 2017 375 ml 60

Tangerine, passion fruit flavors with succulent, elegant and vibrant structure.

Vin Santo del Chianti Classico, Felsina, 2011 375 ml 80

Peach, apricot, pineapple and tropical dried fruit aromas highlighted by softness and elegance.

Sauternes, Barton & Guestier 2018 gl. 19 375 ml 64

Elegant nose with pineapple and apricot aromas, persistent and fruity on the palate.

Sauternes, Château d'Yquem 2017 375 ml 600

Intense aromas of fresh and dried apricot and peach pastry, as well as freshly baked creme brulee, candied and fresh orange and kumquat. The acidity has a big hand in balancing the richness. Pithy finish.

medium bodied white wines

Grüner Veltliner, Federspiel, Domäne Wachau, Terrassen, Wachau, 2021 70

White grapefruit with hints of salinity, white pepper, and a touch of white peach.

Pinot Grigio, Silvio Jermann, Friuli, 2022 70

Intense straw-yellow color; its aroma is intense, full and fruity, with excellent persistence. Its taste is dry, velvety and persistent.

Riesling, Trocken - Vom Schiefer, Ansgar Clusserath, Mosel, 2021 60

Slate, green fruits, delicate flowers, fresh herbs, apple, lime, dry finish.

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Superiore, Velenosi, Marche, 2021 65

Pleasingly fruity and persistent bouquet, with notes of Golden Delicious apples and almonds.

Pouilly-Fuissé, Bouchard Père & Fils, Burgundy, 2020 80

Peach and apple flavors build to a lingering finish of apple and lemon notes.

Sancerre, Daniel Chotard, Loire Valley, 2022 85

Brilliant pale yellow in color with a pure nose reminiscent of citrus and white blossoms. Refreshing and full-bodied on the palate.

Chablis Premier Cru Vaillon, Domäne Vocoret & Fils, Burgundy, 2020 120

Ripe citrus fruit, plum, pastry cream and grapefruit this wine medium bodied with a succulent finish.

Riesling Smaragd - Ried Steiger, Josef Fischer, Wachau, 2019 85

Stone fruit on the first impression with underlying minerality, citrus rind and a lasting finish.

Orvieto Classico Superiore, San Giovanni Della Sala, Antinori, Orvieto 70

Intense aromas of white flower blossoms complemented by hints of citrus and tropical fruit. Excellent balance and structure, savory and fresh finish.

Etna Bianco, Alta Mora, Sicily, 2020 75

Ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs.

Godello - Old Vines, Avancia, Valdeorras, 2021 80

White peach, tart pineapple, honeyed citrus, and salty mineral notes with a great finish.

Givry Premier Cru, "La Grande Berge", Domäne du Clos Salomon, Burgundy 2018 120

Fragrant with pear, quince and woody notes. Intense and precise, with a fresh, blond woodiness, a pure, coated chardonnay with finesse.

Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, Domäne Antonin Guyon, Burgundy, 2018 360

Aromas of acacias, honeysuckle blossoms and nuts. Very pure and powerful with superb depth.

Timorasso - Piccolo Derthona, Spinetta, Piedmont, 2021 90

Fruity scents of pear and peach, with floral aromas, very well balanced, and a lingering finish.

Montagny Premier Cru, Kinghts Templer Cuvée, Chevalier de la Créé, Burgundy, 2020 90

Notes of almond, apricot and pepper, the finish is fresh with a hint of mint.

Meursault - Les Chevalières, Domäne Yvon Clerget, Burgundy, 2020 190

Chiselled wine with distinct minerality and notes of oak, vanilla, honey and toasted nuts. Clean, pronounced, fresh.

Chardonnay, Gary Farrell, Russian River Valley, 2021 100

Flavors of Meyer lemon and lime zest, honey, fresh apricot and peach tartlet.

Meursault Premier Cru, Genevrières, Bouchard Père & Fils, Burgundy, 2018 540

Mouthwatering ripe fruit, poached pear, nectarine, buttered popcorn and marzipan. Minerality, acidity, ripeness and oaky. Perfect balance between these four.

Chardonnay, Rochioli Vineyard, Ramey Cellars, Russian River, 2018 160

This Chardonnay shows great depth of flavor, length of finish, aromatic complexity, and a fine balance between richness and delicacy.

Chassagne-Montrachet Premier Cru - Vide-Bourse, Domäne Fernand & Laurent Pillot, Burgundy, 2020 250

Perfectly balanced, rich, flexible and rounded taste of wine has mineral notes, light acidity and a long finish.

Puligny-Montrachet Premier Cru, Les Folatières, Lucien Le Moine, Burgundy, 2015 320

Voluminous and utterly seamless with flavors of soft citrus fruits and lemon grass.

Bâtard Montrachet Grand Cru, Domäne Bachelet-Monnot, Burgundy, 2022 1400

Rich, vibrant, succulent, bigger-bodied flavors, excellent mid-palate concentration, first-rate length, bitter lemon-inflected finale.

Chardonnay, Kongsgaard, Napa Valley, 2015 450

Concentrated flavors of crème brûlée, butterscotch, bananas foster and roasted pineapple, which all lead up the long, complex finish.

medium bodied red wines

Pinot Noir, Nielson, Monterey County, 2022 70

Medium ruby color. Raspberry and forest fruits on the nos, with some oak. Reasonable acidity and an interesting tannic bite.

Givry Premier Cru - Clos Salomon, Domaine de Clos Salomon, Burgundy, 2018 120

Dark cherry, black pepper, dusty minerals and lively fresh herbs lead to a long finish.

Pinot Noir - Origin, Soter Vineyards, Willamette Valley, 2019 115

Lush black fruits underscored with a seashell minerality and a lush mouthfeel.

Du Château - Beaune Premier Cru, Bouchard Père & Fils, Burgundy, 2020 110

Brisk, bold and juicy, this wine glows with red and purple fruit and floral notes.

Brunello di Montalcino, Vigna del Lago, Val di Suga, Tuscany, 2016 160

Fresh cherry, wild strawberries, elegance on the nose, a precise tannic texture and freshness.

Volnay Premier Cru - Les Santenots, Domaine Yvon Clerget, Burgundy, 2018 260

Mingling rich aromas of blackberries, cassis, espresso roast and cherries. Full-bodied, velvety and enveloping with powdery tannins with smoother finish.

Gevrey-Chambertin - La Justice, Domaine Antonin Guyon, Burgundy, 2020 220

Ruby red color with aromas of morello cherries. Very round and well balanced, with subtle woody tannins and silky texture.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Dei Cantine, Tuscany, 2018 70

Intense bouquet, pungent and mature, with aroma of ripe cherry, plum and violets.

Barolo - Bussia, Giacomo Fenocchio, Piedmont, 2019 210

Raspberry and licorice alongside firm, refined tannins. Fresh acidity keeps it well balanced.

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Les Cadrans, Château Lassègue, Bordeaux, 2018 75

Rhone style blend with strawberry and cinnamon flavors and an intense finish.

Priorat, Ferrer Bobet, Catalonia, 2018 90

Concentrated red wine with complex aromas ripe black fruit and spiced notes

Clos Aplata - Le Petit Clos, Domaines Bournet-Lapostolle, Colchagua Valley, 2019 120

Thyme, bay leaves, currants, blackberries, licorice and pomelo pith. Medium bodied with a long finish.

Valpolicella Superiore, Monte Lodoletta, Dal Forno Romano, Veneto, 2017 220

Pungent nose of violets, amarena cherries, dried figs and lightly charred oak with some toffee; not so much full bodied as full flavored.

Campo De Borja, Veraton, Alto Moncayo, Aragon, 2018 75

Notes of chocolate and black fruits, very warm in mouth and an extremely pleasant finish.

Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru, Domaine Yvon Clerget, Burgundy, 2019 480

Medium to full bodied, notes of plums, cassis, berries, hints of violets, orange and spices.

Côtes de Paso, Halter Ranch, Paso Robles, 2019 85

Rhone style blend with strawberry and cinnamon flavors and an intense finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Obsidian Ridge, Red Hills Lake, 2019 85

Flavors of mulberry and plum, dried oregano are supported by a rich texture.

fuller bodied red wines

Pauillac, Château Pontet-Canet, Bordeaux, 2014 320

Ripe, juicy tannins wrap around a core of intense dark cherry, plum, spice, lavender and tobacco.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Bertani, Veneto 2013 400

Dried cherries combined with spice and smoke, adding a savory element. Tight tannins balanced with firm acidity and immense fruit. Elegant and poised.

Pommard Premier Cru - Les Pezerolles, Domaine Joseph Voillot, Burgundy, 2018 360

Black cherry, blackberry, violet, iron and earthy aromas and flavors matched to a silky texture and long finish.

Pauillac Grand Cru Classé, Château Pichon-Longueville Baron, Bordeaux, 2015 260

Berries, black cherries and a toasted spiciness with opulence from start to finish.

Ribera Del Duero - Malleolus, Bodegas Emilio Moro, Castilla y León, 2019 120

Deep and spicy blackberries and blueberries with a touch of violet, coffee and sandalwood. Rich and dense but fresh and floral with fine-grained tannins.

VIK, La Piu Belle, Valle del Cachapual, 2017 180

Complex and elegant with outstanding freshness in the mouth and beautifully balanced acidity.

Côte Rôtie - Le Gallet Blanc Rouge, Domaine François Villard, Rhône Valley, 2020 110

Long and stylish with salty, sappy black licorice infusing a base of plum and brambly fruit. Warm earth with other savory components and cashmere tannins.

Merlot, Pahlmeyer, Napa Valley, 2021 240

A plush and extravagant style that opens with ripe cherry and red currant flavors laced with vanilla and toasty spice accents as this slowly builds firmness.

Pomerol, Château Le Gay, Bordeaux, 2015 400

Impeccably crafted Pomerol with hints of violets, lavender, cloves, new leather, and a dark-fleshed stone fruits finish.

Shiraz - Amon-Ra, Glaetzer, Barossa, 2018 180

Mocha, blackberry and dried spices, followed by red fruits. It is ull-bodied, rich and concentrated without being jammy.

Meritage - Jayson, Pahlmeyer, Napa Valley, 2021 120

Gentle textured blend with late-picked blueberries and cherries that are layered with vanilla and milk chocolate nuances for an almost sweet finish.

Pauillac, Château Grand Puy Lacoste, Bordeaux, 2015 220

The palate delivers a very assertive array of dark berries and spiced plums with a fresh and vibrant finish.

Amarone della Valpolicella, Monte Lodoletta, Dal Forno Romano, Veneto, 2017 800

A dark, brooding red that effortlessly marries a lovely range of kirsch, blackberry paste, dried mint and eucalyptus flavors.

Châteauneuf du Pape, Mas de Boislauzon, Rhône Valley, 2019 100

Rich with complex flavors. Cinnamon and aged red & black fruits on nose. Pepper, tobacco and spices blend with aged fruit and offer a medium finish.

Tinta de Toro, Numanthia, Toro, Spain, 2018 120

Finely knit and elegant with supple tannins structuring a dark, ripe mix of black currant and black plum fruit. Accents of bay leaf, rose hip and sandalwood.

Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Lewis Cellars, Napa Valley, 2018 200

Ripe and focused, with very lush blackberry compote, cassis and plum and a rich texture.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Quintessa, Napa Valley, 2021 500

Aromas of lavender, dried herbs and grapefruit pith combine with flavors of firm fruits and cocoa. Powder-fine tannin and a mouthwatering finish.

Pauillac Gran Cru Classé, Château Lynch Bages, Bordeaux, 2019 380

Blackberries, lead pencil and violets, full-bodied with a dense, layered palate and tight yet plush tannins,

Cabernet Sauvignon, Colgin, Tychson Hill, Napa Valley, 2019 1500 - one bottle per table.

Full-bodied, rich and velvety with layer upon layer of red, black and blue fruits spiked with tons of spicy accents.
