SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION

DEADLINE: February 1 to your state chairman

- The number and amount of scholarships will be determined annually. Currently it is 1 scholarship of \$1000 per year. Applicants may apply each year.
- One-year scholarships are available to juniors, seniors and graduate students.
- Equal Opportunity shall be provided to all applicants.
- Sophomores may apply for their junior year.
- College/university must be accredited and listed on the official website of the U.S. Department of Education http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/Search.aspx.

Applicant Eligibility

Applications under the following conditions are not eligible:

- International or Foreign Exchange Students.
- Doctoral program students.
- Study abroad on fellowships or internships.

Applicants must meet all the following criteria:

- Must be a US Citizen or Permanent Legal Resident of the United States.
- Must be attending school full-time or as defined by PR:
 - Undergraduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 graded hours of classes.
 - Graduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 graded hours of classes.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Must be planning a career related to gardening, landscape design, environmental issues, floral design or horticulture.
- Previous applicants may re-apply (whether awarded or not)
- Must be majoring in one of the following fields of study:
 - Agronomy
 - Agriculture Education
 - Floriculture
 - Horticulture
 - Landscape Design
 - Botany, Biology
 - Forestry
 - Wildlife Science

- Plant Pathology/Science
- Habitat or Forest/Systems Ecology
- Environmental Concerns (Management: Environmental, Horticulture Resource/Environmental Behavior)
- Environmental Conservation (inc. Engineering, Law etc.)
- Land Management and/or other related or allied subjects

Selection Criteria

- All applications received by February 1 will be judged by a state committee in order to choose one winning application. State winners will be sent by the state chairman by March 1st to the PR Scholarship Chairman.
- The following sample Scale of Points may be used for the evaluation of each application:

Academic Record	40%
Applicant's Letter	25%
Listing of Honors/Extracurricular Activities/Work Experience	13%
Financial Need	15%
Recommendations	5%
Conformance	2%

Description of Funds

- Awarded funds will be mailed in late July to the Financial Aid Office of the institution at which
 the student is enrolled. Enrollment will be verified. No funds will be sent directly to the
 student
- The student and Financial Aid Officer will determine how the money is to be spent: tuition, food, housing, books, etc.
- In the event of a change in a student's major to one other than those listed above, or if the student withdraws from the school; the balance of the funds must be returned to Pacific Region Garden Clubs.

Application Procedure

- The following documents must be submitted: (front side only)
 - 1. PR Scholarship Application form
 - 2. PR Financial Aid Form
 - 3. Complete academic transcripts
 - 4. Letter from applicant, one page –(front side only)
 - 5. List of extracurricular activities, honors, recognitions received within the last three years (front side only)
 - 6. Two letters of recommendation, one page per letter front side only
- All of the documents are to be submitted by email or by mail, **in one large envelope**. Do not bind or staple documents.
- Email or Mail applications to the State Garden Club Scholarship Chairman for the state in which the applicant is a legal resident, even if the student is attending an out-of-state school. A list of State Scholarship Chairmen is available on the National Garden Clubs' website.
