

Pacific Region Garden Clubs
Youth Pollinator Poster Contest *NEW*



This contest is an opportunity for local Garden Clubs to connect with the youth in their communities. Classes and presentations should encourage youth to take a personal role in conserving and promoting pollinator habitat and awareness, as well as the importance of caring for our environment.

Grades K-6



All posters must be sponsored by a local Garden Club.



Poster 8 ½ X 11 showcasing one of the many pollinators. Poster may picture multiples of the same pollinator but not different pollinators. Posters will be judged for originality, design, creativity, and artwork.

Crayon, poster paint, watercolors, pencil, markers, etc may be used.
The color, type and texture of paper used is up to the creator.



No three-dimensional, computer scanned or electronically generated posters will be accepted. Poster may include artwork that is pasted on a second piece of paper, but it must be flat, 3D not allowed.



Only first place posters per grade should be sent by state's designated award chairman to the region's pollinator poster contest chairman by the **March 1st deadline**.

State chairman must also send a list of entries on a PRGC general award application with the pertinent award and contact information completed on the top of the form.

On the top right hand corner on back of poster in a space of 3X4 inches, write artist's name, grade, sponsoring garden club and home state. Do not use dark marker as it may show through to front of poster.

Sponsoring club or state should offer an Award of Appreciation to all participants. Fill-able certificates will be available on the PRGC website.



Winning posters should be copied, as they may not be returned. Originals only will be accepted for competition.
