The following excerpts are from the paragraph Vernetta wrote after when she shared the Covid survey results. I am reprinting with Vernetta's permission. We need to do anything we can do to promote grace and respectful conversation.

I was reminded that although our belief in God unites us, our individual personalities and ideas are varied.

One word kept coming up in my mind – GRACE. What is your understanding of that word? Grace wasn't a commonly used word in my life experiences until recently, within the past 10-15 years. Of course, we have heard of "God's Grace", the all-encompassing love and understanding that God can give. But I never considered my personal opportunities for offering grace to others that offended me or thought differently than I did.

My hope is that we all learn to give GRACE to others that choose to respond differently than we do - to co-workers, to church family, to church and school leadership, and to family members.

Sing unto the Lord a new song! What are the hymns and songs you yearned to sing as a congregation during the pandemic months? Now that we're returning to live singing, the worship planning team is bringing back "Heart Songs"! There is a box and slips of paper on the narthex table under the windows for you to submit the titles of hymns and songs you'd like to sing - you can include your name OR remain anonymous. These songs will be denoted in our bulletin with a heart, so that we'll all know when we are singing someone's special request. For now, please limit your requests to songs that are found in any of the hymnals and hymnal supplement books in our pews.
