Gordon Scoville News—December, 2020

How's Gordon? He remains thrilled to be in his own house again, and enjoys an occasional walk outdoors! In a visit yesterday, Gordon mentioned that he physically tires more easily now, has a bit more difficulty swallowing food, and finds that just a little supplemental oxygen gives him a boost when he is walking. Afternoon resting re-energizes him. Gordon continues to self-isolate to reduce exposure to any potential infections that would challenge his severely compromised immune system, with caregivers wearing masks when they visit. Your prayers, calls from 9 AM to Noon (see his cell number below), and cards continue to be important to Gordon, and are very much appreciated!

Monthly Receipts, Distributions, and Current Balance: The benevolent fund for Gordon, administered by Central Plains Mennonite Conference, received \$200 in the month of November. After deducting \$65 for his December apartment rental (the balance of his rent was covered by another donor), and adding back the November donor deposits, the current balance as of December 1st is \$5,516—that provides a wonderful emergency fund cushion!

With the much-improved budgeted expenses, we will be able to reduce gift requests and monthly distributions for Gordon's expenses. From now on, we are projecting only \$65-\$150 monthly withdrawals from the CPMC benevolent fund! Praise God! Thank you for this generous outpouring of support!
