Corona virus update: Scientists are gradually learning more about this new virus and how it spreads. It is unfortunate that some initial recommendations have since been changed. That is understandably frustrating and confusing. We were initially told that people who were not sick did not spread the virus. Studies now clearly show that was wrong, and it is now suspected that up to 50% of spread comes from infected people who don't feel sick. This means that mask wearing is more important than was initially thought. Furthermore, studies now have shown that common "non-medical" masks prevent the virus from escaping an infected person better than they keep a healthy person from inhaling virus particles that float in the air from non-mask wearing people. So we wear masks not so much to protect ourselves, but rather to keep us from spreading the virus to others, even when we may feel well. It seems to me that applying this knowledge respects the Golden Rule: "Do unto others as you would have others do to you." Let us all do our part to keep each other safe. Dennis Ries
