Faith and Leadership Scholarship: Freeman Academy is accepting applications for the Faith and Leadership Scholarship for students in grades 9-12. Recipients receive 40% off regular high school tuition and a scholarship to attend summer leadership training through their denomination or an approved regional or national program. Like all Freeman Academy high school students, recipients take courses in Bible content, church history and contemporary global Christianity, and in Christian discipleship and practice. Students also attend chapel, where they hear presentations from a range of Christian traditions as well as participate in spiritual formation activities. Freeman Academy families represent a variety of faith backgrounds, which are incorporated into student life on campus.

Applicants must be new students with a GPA of 3.5 or higher who wish to develop their leadership skills through contributions to the school. An interview and short essay are required. Scholarship recipients who maintain a 3.5 GPA and complete the leadership requirements, receive the 40% discount each year of high school. Details at FreemanAcademy.org/scholarships/.
