DEAR PARENTS:

The last month of preschool is here! The children have been practicing the songs at preschool for the year end concert and graduation.

The celebration will be held at the preschool this year. Due to the fire code safety sitting capacity of the preschool, only immediate family members for each child are allowed to attend this celebration. This celebration will be held at the preschool on Monday, June 15th, 2026. **All students must attend this event** on this day. The morning concert will be at 9:00am; the afternoon concert will be at 12:30pm. The event will be approximately 1-1.5 hours in length. Tuesday, June 16th will be a regular class day for those children who usually have classes on a Tuesday.

On the last 2 days of school - on both June 18th & 19th, we will be celebrating "un-Birthdays" in pajamas with the students whose birthdays are not during the school year or did not have a chance to celebrate. Please email me to let me know if you would like us to celebrate your child's birthday with them on one of those days. Yes, it will also be pajama day on both days!!

A reminder to all parents that there are still spots available in both the **2026 Academic Discovery Summer Camp and September 2026 to June 2027 Preschool Program**. The deadline for our summer program for the month of July is Friday, June 26th. Our summer program is perfect to help your children continue to retain what they learned during the school year. Regarding summer camp, if we do not have enough children signed up for camp, due to low enrollment, those sessions will be cancelled. The preschool will be closed for August, but I will still be reachable by email for fall enrollment.
