We would like to remind all families that although our winter has been mild so far, the cold weather will eventually be here. PLEASE make sure that you check the weather daily and dress your child appropriately. Although the environment inside the preschool is always at a comfortable temperature you will never know if we have to exit the classroom due to an emergency. If there is an emergency we will have to leave the building regardless of the weather outside. If your child does not have the appropriate clothing for the weather they will be cold, **WE DO NOT have extra outdoor wear for them.** PLEASE also make sure that your child always has a zipper hoodie or sweater brought to preschool with them at all times, whether it be worn on them when they come or it can be kept in their backpacks.

Illness Protocol: As per the Government of Alberta, it is recommended that symptomatic individuals stay home until they are feeling well, are able to fully participate in all normal school related activities. Please make sure that your child has been free of fever for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication and have NO symptoms of coughs and runny (or congested) noses. This is because your child's symptoms caused by other viruses that can be spread to others.
