The Lord had said to Abram, “Go from your country, your people and your father’s household to the land I will show you.

Genesis 12:1

God would later change Abram’s name to Abraham.

Abraham was to pack up, leave his home, his family, all of his friends and head out into the desert. God didn’t tell him where he was going but promised to bless him if he went. God led Abraham to the Land of Canaan (the Promised Land).

Abraham was 75 years old when God told him to go!

Genesis 15:5

When Abraham told God that the 1 thing he desperately wanted was a son, the Lord promised him that he would have as many descendants as the stars that he could see in the sky.

So why did they name their son, Isaac?

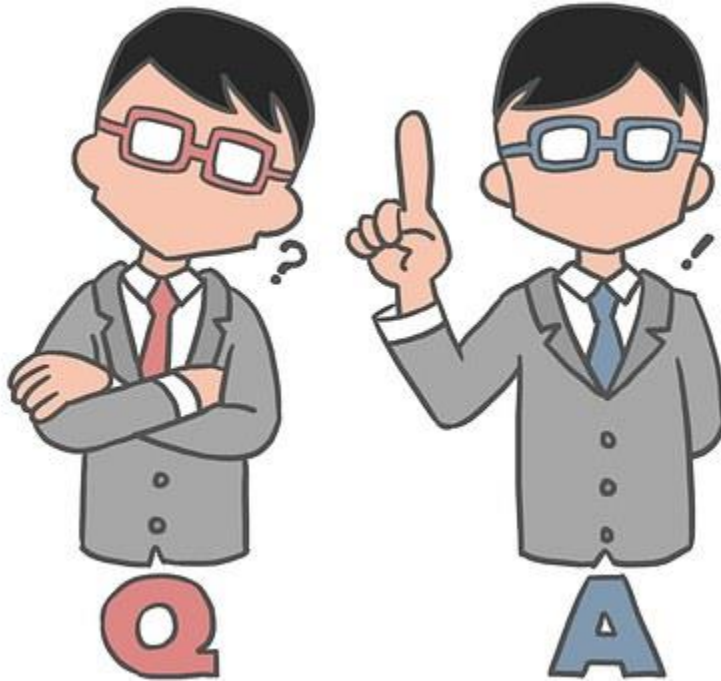
They named their son Isaac because Sarah had laughed when hearing she would have a baby in her old age. Even when she was much younger, she wasn't able to have children!
