Lesson 1 – The Building of a Widow’s Faith – FREE - This lesson teaches your children about having faith in God when everything looks bleak around them. It was written around the story of the widow who along with her son are caught up in a famine and starving to death, that is until Elijah the Prophet comes along (1 Kings 17: 7-24).

Lesson 6 – Jesus’s First Miracle – This lesson teaches your students about Jesus's first miracle (John 2: 1-11), turning water into wine at a wedding feast. It also reminds them that Jesus is alive and is still able to do miracles today.

Lesson 7 – The Thankful Leper - This lesson teaches your students the story about the 10 lepers in Luke 17: 11 – 19 and how to have a thankful heart. **Recommended for Thanksgiving.**

Lesson 8 – Walking with Peter - This lesson teaches your students the story about Peter walking on water (Matthew 14: 22-33) and how, when his faith wavered, he began to sink. It also reminds them to never lose faith in Jesus.

Lesson 9 – The Pharisee and the Tax Collector - This lesson teaches your students through a parable spoken by Jesus (Luke 18: 9-14) to be humble and admit when they are wrong instead of lifting themselves up in pride for all to see.

Lesson 10 – The Prodigal Son - This lesson teaches your students through a parable spoken by Jesus (Luke 15: 11-24) to be wise with their money, listen to their parent's instruction and how much God loves them; even when they mess up.

Lesson 11 – Gideon Battles the Bully - This lesson teaches your students that God can and often does use the most unlikely of people to do great things just as he did Gideon to defeat the Midianites (Judges 6 and 7).

Lesson 12 – The Book of Ruth - This lesson teaches your students the story of Ruth (Ruth 1-4) who was redeemed by a man named by Boaz after her husband had died. It also teaches how we needed a Redeemer which became Jesus when he died on a cross for our sins.

Lesson 13 – The Foolishness of King Uzziah - This lesson teaches your students the story of King Uzziah (2 Chronicles 25-26) who began his reign serving God, only to become full of pride and find himself humbled by the Lord in a big way. Your students will learn the power that pride can have over one's life when they allow themselves to be consumed by it.

Lesson 14 – The Life of Joseph - This lesson teaches your students the story of Joseph (Genesis, Chapters 37, 39-47) who was sold as a slave by his own brothers, only to rise as the second in command in all of Egypt and save his family from a famine in the land. Your students will learn how sometimes God allows bad things to happen as part of a bigger plan to do something great.

Lesson 15 – Gehazi and the Big Lie - This lesson teaches your students the story of Gehazi (2 Kings 5), the servant to the prophet Elisha. He had a problem with coveting the things of others and ended up paying a costly price for taking things that were not his. Your students will learn not to desire the things of others and trust God to provide them with everything that they need.

Lesson 16 – Saul Sees the Light - This lesson teaches your students the story behind the encounter that Saul (also known as Paul) had with Jesus on the road to Damascus where he was going to persecute Christians. They will discover that anyone can change when they meet Jesus and that God has a plan for every one of us. They will also learn some interesting facts about Saul.

Lesson 17 – What are 5 Loaves and 2 Fish to So Many? - This lesson teaches your students the story of Jesus feeding the 5,000 (Actually, that was 5,000 men, with women and children included it was more like 15 – 20,000 people). They will discover that God did so much with so little that day and he is able to do for them, much more than they can ever imagine.

Lesson 18 – Love Thy Neighbor – This lesson teaches your students the Parable of the Good Samaritan. It also helps them to not only understand what Jesus was trying to convey when he spoke it to the people but also how to apply it in their own lives.

Lesson 19 – Prison Break - This lesson teaches your students that their prayers are powerful and to never doubt that God will answer them. It centers around the Apostle Peter who had been locked up in prison by King Herod. Many people prayed for him and when God did what they had all asked for in prayer, they were astonished.

Lesson 20 – Lazarus, Come Out - This lesson teaches your students the story of Lazarus (John 11: 1-45) who Jesus raised from the dead. It will encourage them to believe that with God, anything is possible.

Lesson 21 – The Book of Jonah - This lesson teaches your students about Jonah (Jonah 1-3) who was instructed by God to go and preach to the Ninevites, but decided to try to run from the Lord. This story is much more than Jonah being swallowed by a big fish (possibly a whale). Your students will learn about obedience and that God loves even those people that they may think are beyond saving.

Lesson 22 – Balaam and his Talking Donkey - This lesson teaches your students about Balaam (Numbers 22: 1-33) who loved money so much that he became spiritually blind. So blind that his donkey could see better than him and protects his life from an angel sent by God. Not only that, but the donkey talks to Balaam in this story. Your students will learn about keeping their eyes focused on the things of God and not those things they feel they must acquire.

Lesson 23 – Dinner Date with a Den of Lions - This lesson teaches your students about the prophet Daniel who continued praying to God even when that meant he would be thrown into a den of hungry lions (Daniel 6). They will learn about integrity and never compromising their beliefs.

Lesson 24 – A Very Expensive Pot of Stew - This lesson teaches your students about how Esau didn't value his birthright and his twin brother Jacob would stop at nothing to get it. (Genesis 25:21-34 27:1-38). They will learn about valuing the blessings they receive, the most important of all, salvation through Jesus Christ.

Lesson 25 – King Jehoshaphat and his Singing Soldiers - This lesson teaches your students about how King Jehoshaphat (2 Chronicles 1-28), went to battle against an army much larger than his own without any weapons and came out victorious because God fought for him. They will learn to always have faith, even when the odds against them seem insurmountable.

Lesson 26 – Shipwrecked - This lesson teaches your students that listening to the wrong people and going along with the crowd results in making a bad decision. In this story (inspired by Acts 27), the Apostle Paul is on a ship that's bound for Rome so he can stand before Caesar. After barely making it to Crete, he warns everyone on board about the impending disaster if they attempt to sail on instead of harboring until Spring. They don't listen to him and must now suffer the consequences for the choice they made.

Lesson 27 – The Small Man in the Sycamore Tree - This lesson teaches your students the story of Zacchaeus, a small, but powerful, rich, dishonest chief-tax collector who Jesus calls to come down from a sycamore tree. (Luke 19: 1-10). Your students will discover how a life, no matter how badly lived can be changed in an instant when a person has an encounter with Jesus. This story should encourage all of us to share the gospel with everyone, not just those we think are worthy of hearing it.

Lesson 28 – Love Fulfills the Law - This lesson teaches your students the story of a Pharisee who asked Jesus a question, "Which is the Greatest Commandment in the Law?". Your students will discover how they can live a life pleasing to God and in total obedience to him if they can just follow the two Commandments Jesus shares with that Pharisee.

Lesson 29 – More Than Just a Fishy Tale - This lesson teaches your students about the time that Jesus sent the Apostle Peter to the Sea of Galilee to catch a fish with a 4-Drachma coin in its mouth (Matthew 17: 22-27) so they could pay their taxes. Your students will learn that sometimes God provides in unusual ways when we put our faith in him.

Lesson 30 – Tamara - This lesson teaches your students the story about a 12-year-old girl who Jesus raises from the dead. It also includes Jesus's encounter with a woman that had a blood disorder that he heals as well. (Matthew 9: 18-25, Mark 5: 21-43 Luke 8: 40-56). Your students will learn to never lose their faith, even when things look bleak. Sometimes God desires us to be patient as he works things out in our lives.

Lesson 31 – A Basket Floating Among the Reeds - This lesson teaches your students about the birth of Moses, which occurred at the worst of times. Although Pharaoh had a plan to get rid of all male Hebrew babies born in his country, God had a plan too. (Exodus 1:6-22, 2:1-10, 6:20). Your students will learn to trust God no matter what and that just like Moses, God has great plans for their lives as well.

Lesson 32 – Run Moses Run - This lesson teaches your students about one of the times in Moses's life where he had a serious error in judgment; in this case, killing an Egyptian slave master. He would have to run for his life, settle in a foreign land for 40 years and go from being a prince to becoming a shepherd (Exodus 2:11-21, Acts 7:20-29, Hebrews 11:24-27). Your students will learn that even when we mess up, God still has a plan for our lives. It may need to change, but it will still accomplish what it was set out to do.

Lesson 33 – Moses and the Burning Bush - This lesson teaches your students about an 80-year-old prophet named Moses, who encounters a burning bush that gets his attention long enough for God to speak to him. The Lord instructs him to go back to Egypt to rescue the Israelites from slavery. (Exodus 3, 4, 5, 6, 7:1-13). Your students will learn that when they feel inadequate, just as Moses did in this lesson, God is more than enough to do whatever the Lord asks of them.

Lesson 34 – The Ten Plagues - This lesson teaches your students about each of the ten plagues that God sent down upon the nation of Egypt and the hardness of Pharaoh's heart. (Exodus 7:13-24, 8, 9, 10, 11:4-5). Your students will learn to guard their own hearts, so theirs won't become like Pharaoh's.

Lesson 35 – Escape from Egypt - This lesson teaches your students the dramatic conclusion of Moses's commission to free the Israelites from Egyptian captivity (Exodus 11, 12:1-13, 12:29-36, 12:40-41, 13:17-19, 14:5-28). Your students will learn to persevere when life gets difficult because with God on their side, they will always come out victorious.

Lesson 36 – A Manna and Quail Buffet - This lesson teaches your students to be thankful for all God provides for them (Exodus 16). Even as adults, we sometimes think the "Grass is greener on the other side," just as the Israelites in today's lesson as they reminisced about how things were so much better for them in Egypt. Your students will also learn that God is not pleased with us when we grumble and complain.

Lesson 37 – The Ten Commandments - This lesson teaches your students about the time when God chose to make a covenant with the Israelites and gave them the Ten Commandments (Exodus 19-23, 25-28, 31: 12-18, 32: 7-16 Deuteronomy 5: 1-27). Your students will also learn that God desires to have a relationship with every one of them and sees us as his most treasured possession.

Lesson 38 – Let Us Make a Golden Calf - This lesson teaches your students about the Israelite's disobedience, making themselves a golden calf to worship just after God had commanded them to worship him only and to create no idols (Exodus 32-34, 36: 8-38, 37: 1-9, Deuteronomy 9:21). Your students will also learn that God requires us to be obedient to him.

Lesson 39 – Spies in the Land - This lesson teaches your students about the Israelite's lack of faith in God after they had sent out spies to survey the Promised Land (Numbers 13 - 14, Deuteronomy 1: 19-46). Your students will learn how God feels when we grumble and complain instead of putting our trust in him.

Lesson 40 – Onward to the Promised Land - This lesson concludes a 10-part series on the life of Moses with the Israelites about to enter the Promised Land. Sadly, Moses wasn't allowed to go along due to his own disobedience. (Numbers 20, Numbers 21: 4-9, Numbers 27: 12-23, Deuteronomy 31: 1-8, Deuteronomy 34: 1-5). Your students will learn that their lives will be much better if they are obedient to God and keep themselves from grumbling and complaining.

Lesson 41 – Jesus Calms the Storm - This lesson contains 3 different stories on faith (Matthew 8:5-15, Matthew 8:23-27, Mark 4:35-41, Luke 8:22-25). Your students will learn to stand on their faith when the storms of life come their way.

Lesson 42 – Loving God and Others - In this lesson, Jesus answers a question (Which is the Greatest Commandment) from an Expert of the Law. (Mark 12: 28-34). He responds that we should love the Lord with all our heart, mind, soul and strength. He doesn't stop there but also tells us that the second greatest commandment is to love our neighbor as ourselves. How do we love God with all our heart, mind, soul and strength and our neighbor as ourselves? Well, that's what your students will learn from this lesson.

Lesson 43 – Honor Your Father and Mother - "Honor Your Father and Mother" is the 5th of the Ten Commandments that were given to Moses, thousands of years ago. Obviously, God feels strongly about children obeying their parents! The Bible has much to say about this commandment and in this lesson, your students will discover how to honor their parents in several ways that are pleasing to God.

Lesson 44 – The Power of Our Words - This lesson will teach your students about their tongues, which the Bible tells us no man can tame and the power behind the words they speak. It will help them to realize that what they say can be very impactful, either building a person up or tearing them down.

Lesson 45 – Blind, No More - This lesson will introduce your students to a man who had been blind since birth and gets healed by Jesus. The disciples that were with Jesus wondered who had sinned to cause the man to be without sight. Your students will discover that the blind man's inability to see had nothing to do with anyone sinning but was part of God's plan to demonstrate his power so that many would believe.

Lesson 46 – Nehemiah Must be Stopped – This lesson teaches your students about a Judean man named Nehemiah. He grew up during the Babylonian captivity, which caused him to reside in Babylon. One day he would learn that the walls that once protected the city of Jerusalem had been destroyed, offering no protection to those still living there. He knew that he had to do something about it. Your students will learn through Nehemiah's persistence and God's strength, that they should never give up when the Lord has a task for them to complete.

Lesson 47 – Noah and the Great Flood – This lesson teaches your students about Noah, an evil generation, the construction of an enormous ark in the middle of the desert and the great flood. It will encourage them to persevere, even when everyone else thinks they have completely lost their minds. They will also discover that God can use anyone (Noah was around 500 years old when he started building the ark) at any time in their life and that he protects those who love him.

Lesson 48 – Esther, Queen of Persia – This lesson teaches your students about Esther, a young, Jewish woman who became the Queen of Persia. Esther must have been very confused when she was taken by force to King Xerxes's palace where she would be one of many unwilling contestants in his quest for a new queen. Your students will see how God had plans for Esther's life and does for theirs as well. This lesson can be taught on its own or as Part 1 of a 3-Part Series (Lessons 49 and 50 tie together with this one).

Lesson 49 – Pride Goes Before Destruction – This lesson teaches your students about Haman who was second in command of the kingdom of Persia. His pride became so out of control that it ended up costing him his life. Your students will learn how dangerous an enemy pride can become if left unchecked. This lesson can be taught on its own or as Part 2 of a 3-Part Series (Lessons 48 and 50 tie together with this one).

Lesson 50 – Can Queen Esther Save her People? – Before Haman, who was second in command of Persia was taken away to the gallows, he had a law written that gave the Persians permission to kill all the Jewish people on the 13th day of the month of Adar. Unfortunately for Esther, Persian laws could not be repealed. How can she now save her people from certain death? Your students will see God’s hand at work and learn about the celebration of Purim in this lesson. It can be taught on its own or as Part 3 of a 3-Part Series (Lessons 48 and 49 tie together with this one).

Lesson 51 – The Story of Adam and Eve – This lesson from Genesis, Chapters 2 & 3 takes us back to the very beginning of mankind. Adam and Eve are about to be tempted by a serpent that can talk. Will they listen to him and make a very bad choice or will they remain obedient to God? Your students will learn that God gives them the freedom to make their own choices but that there are consequences when we are disobedient.

Lesson 52 – Am I My Brother’s Keeper? – This lesson from Genesis 4: 1-16, tells the story of Cain and Abel. It reflects on how they both gave offerings to the Lord but with different hearts and God’s reaction to each of them. It also includes Cain’s reaction (the killing of his brother Abel), when his offering is rejected and the consequences he would suffer for what he had done. Your students will learn that God accepts us when we give him our very best from a good heart and how sin is at the door, waiting when we don’t do what is right.

Lesson 53 – Elijah vs the 450 Prophets of Baal – This lesson from 1 Kings 18, tells in vivid detail, the challenge thrown down by Elijah the Prophet to the 450 Prophets of Baal to determine whose god was really God. Your students will learn about how powerful their prayers can be and God’s forgiveness for us when we turn our hearts back to him.

Lesson 54 – Hannah’s Amazing Gift for the Lord – This lesson from 1 Samuel 1, tells the story of a barren woman named Hannah who after 10 years, prayed for a son. She vowed to give him back to God, if he would answer her prayer. Your students will learn about how the impossible becomes possible when a person pours their heart out to God. They will also see the blessings Hannah would receive for honoring her vow. Oh, and by the way, the child she would have was Samuel the Prophet!

Lesson 55 – Elisha and God’s Chariots of Fire – This lesson from 2 Kings 6:8-23, begins with an on-going war between Aram and Israel. The king of Aram desperately wants to capture King Jehoram (the king of Israel) but Elisha the prophet keeps messing things up for him. It isn’t long before the Aramean army comes after Elisha but because God intervenes, things go really bad for the enemy soldiers. This lesson is not only about faith, but what can happen when we show mercy and kindness to those who are against us.

Lesson 56 – The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant – This lesson from Matthew 18:21-35 is centered around the Parable of the Unmerciful Servant. It is told by Jesus after the Apostle Peter asked him a simple question about his obligation to forgive others. Little did Peter know how deep of an answer he would receive. Your students will learn that God expects all of us to forgive others sincerely and not just once or twice. They will also discover how freeing forgiveness is when it is done from the heart.

Lesson 57 – Tabitha, Get Up! – This lesson from Acts 9:32-42 is about a wealthy woman with the heart of a servant. God’s calling for her life was to make clothing for the widows of Joppa who no longer had anyone to provide for them. Suddenly, something happens to Tabitha. Fortunately, the Apostle Peter is near-by. What will he do, what will God do and what will happen to Tabitha? Through this lesson, your students will be encouraged to take on the heart of a servant and will see how powerful our prayers can be when we kneel before our Mighty God.

Lesson 58 – The Wisdom of King Solomon – The Bible doesn’t tell us how old Solomon was when he became the king of Israel, but we can surmise that he was very young. He realized right away that he would need wisdom to lead the people and made his request known to God. The Lord then answered in a big way. Through this lesson, your students will learn about King Solomon’s early years and see the wisdom he acquired in action. They will also discover that God wants to give them what they ask for when their requests are made with a sincere heart and for the right reasons.

Lesson 59 – Restoration by the Sea – This lesson tells of yet another miracle performed by Jesus shortly after he had risen from the tomb (A miraculous catch of fish on the Sea of Galilee). It then focuses on the Apostle Peter who had denied Jesus 3 times and felt like he was no longer a part of the huge plans the Lord had for him. (Matthew 16:18 – And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not overcome it). Through this lesson, your students will discover that even when they mess up badly, they can still be used by God.

Lesson 60 – Temptation in the Wilderness – This lesson opens with the devil's fall from heaven and Jesus being baptized by John the Baptist. It then covers the three temptations that the Lord faced in the wilderness and shows how he got the victory each time.
