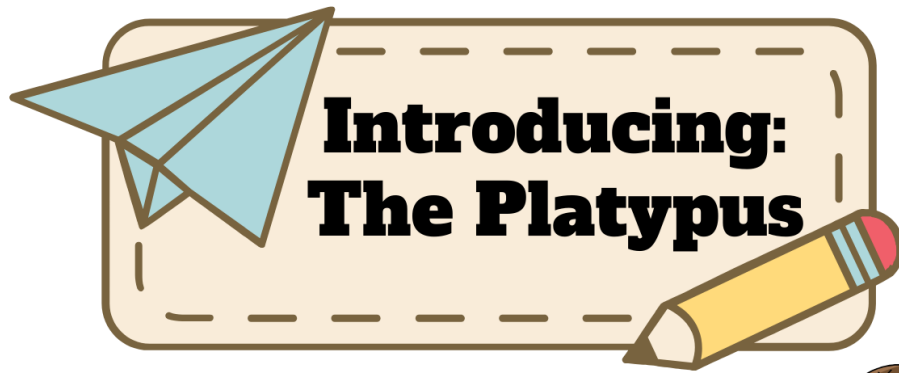




The platypus is such a weird creature that when the first drawings and descriptions of it were shared in the late 1700's, scientist thought it was some sort of bad joke!

When a platypus is born, it is only the size of a jellybean!

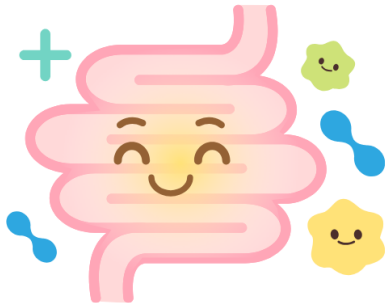
A male platypus will grow to an average length of 20 inches while the female platypus will have an average length of 17 inches.

Platypuses spend 40% of the night hunting for food on the bottom of the river. They scoop up insects, larvae, shellfish and worms with their bills.



Did you know...

... that the platypus doesn't have teeth or a stomach?



They pick up gravel from the bottom of the river that helps them mash up their food and then digest those yummy morsels in their intestines.

The platypus uses its tail to push it through the water, help it to steer in the right direction and to carry things back home.

If you want to know how healthy a platypus is, just look at its tail.

Platypuses are very playful and can live up to 11 years in the wild.

... that you should never pick up a male platypus?

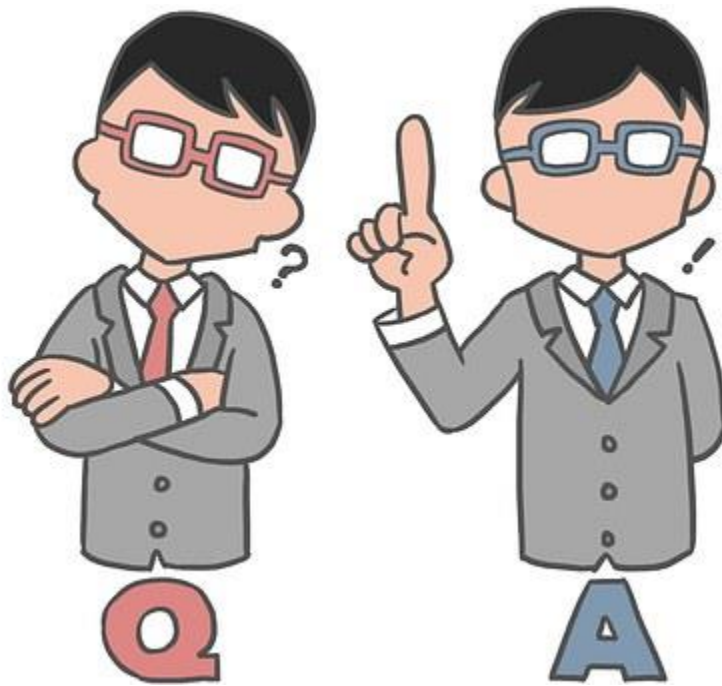


They have sharp stingers on the heels of their hind feet which won't kill you or I, but cause us a whole lot of pain!
