

How Much Do You Know about Moses?

Here are 42 Questions for Your Family:

1.) What was the name of the river that Baby Moses floated in? The Nile River.

2.) What did Pharaoh command the midwives to do when they delivered a Hebrew baby boy? He commanded them to take its life.

3.) What did Pharaoh instruct the people in his kingdom to do to all the Hebrew baby boys born in Egypt? Throw them into the Nile River.

4.) What did Pharaoh's daughter decide to do with Moses after she found him floating in a basket in the Nile River? To make him her son.

5.) What did Moses see an Egyptian soldier doing to one of the Israelites that made him go into a rage? He saw the Egyptian soldier beating the Israelite.

6.) What did Moses do to the Egyptian soldier that was beating the Israelite? He killed him.

7.) When Moses tried to break up a fight between two of his Hebrew brothers the next day, what did one of them say to him? Are you going to kill me like you did that Egyptian soldier yesterday?

8.) Where did Moses run off to after he killed an Egyptian soldier? To Midian.

9.) What was so odd about the burning bush Moses saw? It was on fire but it never burned up.

10.) What were the two signs that God gave Moses so that the Israelites and Pharaoh might believe that he had been sent to rescue the Israelites? The first sign - his staff would turn into a snake when he threw it down and become a staff once more when he picked it up. The second sign – when he placed his hand in his cloak it would become leprous and placing it into his cloak a second time would heal it so it would be normal once again.

11.) Who went along with Moses when he returned to Egypt? His brother Aaron.

12.) What did Moses request from Pharaoh, time and time again? To let the Israelites go.

13.) What did one of the plagues do to the Nile River? It turned it into blood.

14.) When God sent down the Plague of the Frogs, where did some of them end up? In Pharaoh's palace, his bedroom and even in his bed. They also found their way into the homes of the Egyptian people.

15.) What was the last of the plagues that would strike Egypt? The Plague of the Firstborn. All Egyptian firstborn sons would die and the firstborn of the cattle too.

16.) Why did God keep sending plagues upon the land of Egypt? Because Pharaoh wouldn't let the Israelites leave.

17.) What did God promise to do when he saw the blood on the door frames of the Israelite's houses? He would pass over those homes, sparing the firstborn son living inside.

18.) What holiday is celebrated each year to commemorate God passing over the homes of the Israelites and only killing the Egyptian firstborn children? The Passover.

20.) What happened to the water once Pharaoh and his entire army were in the middle of the Red Sea? It came back together, killing Pharaoh and all his soldiers.

21.) What did the people do when they discovered that the water in Marah was bitter? They grumbled and complained.

22.) How many mornings each week did God send manna down to the people? 6.

23.) Since God didn't send manna down on the Sabbath Day, what were the Israelites supposed to do on the sixth day? Collect a double portion so they wouldn't have to do any work on the Sabbath Day.

24.) What happened to the bread that some of the Israelites kept overnight after Moses told them not to? It became full of maggots and smelled bad.

25.) What does the word manna mean? "What is it?" The Israelites didn't know at first what God had sent them when they saw it.

26.) What did the Israelites have to do if they wanted to honor their covenant with God? Obey all his commandments.

27.) What was the name of the book that Moses wrote in after God gave him some additional laws and commands? The Book of the Covenant.

28.) What did God use to write the Ten Commandments onto the 2 stone tablets? His finger.

29.) What did the Israelites build that angered God while Moses was meeting with him on Mount Sinai? A golden calf.

30.) What was Moses carrying down Mount Sinai after his first visit with God? **Two stone tablets that contained the Ten Commandments.**

31.) What happened to the two stone tablets when Moses saw the Israelites worshipping the golden calf? In anger, he threw them to the ground and they broke in pieces.

32.) What did Moses do to the golden calf that the Israelites had made? He tossed it into the fire, then when it melted, he ground it down to a fine powder.

33.) What did Moses make the people do at the stream after he tossed in the remains of the golden calf? He made them drink the water from it.

34.) What was different about Moses's face when came off the mountain the second time? It was glowing from being in the presence of the Lord.

35.) How many spies did Moses send to the Promised Land? 12.

36.) What did 10 of the 12 spies think after exploring the land? They found it to be a beautiful place, but they didn't think they could claim the land because there were giants there. They would be too powerful to defeat.

37.) What were the names of the 2 spies that felt that they could go up and possess the Promised Land? Joshua and Caleb.

38.) What did the Israelites try to do after Joshua and Caleb shared their opinions with them? They tried to stone them.

39.) What did God instruct Moses to do so the people and their livestock would have water to drink? He was told to speak to the rock.

40.) What penalty did Moses and Aaron suffer because Moses struck the rock instead of speaking to it? They would no longer get to enter into the Promised Land.

41.) How old was Moses when he died? 120 years old.

42.) What did God allow Moses to do before he died? He let him see the Promised Land from the top of Mount Nebo.
