Only 1 Continent on the Earth has no ants! Which one is it?

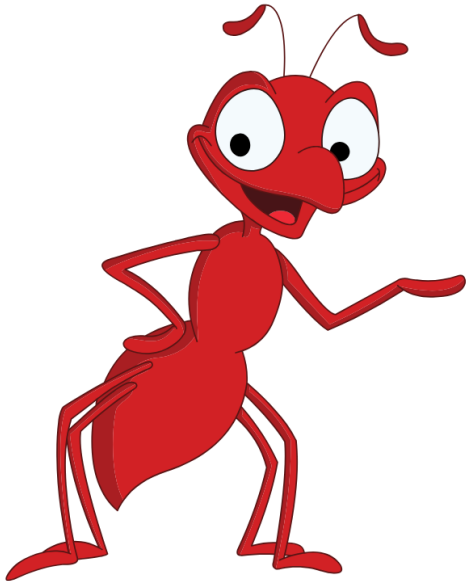

Ants don't have lungs. Oxygen enters their bodies through tiny holes in their sides.



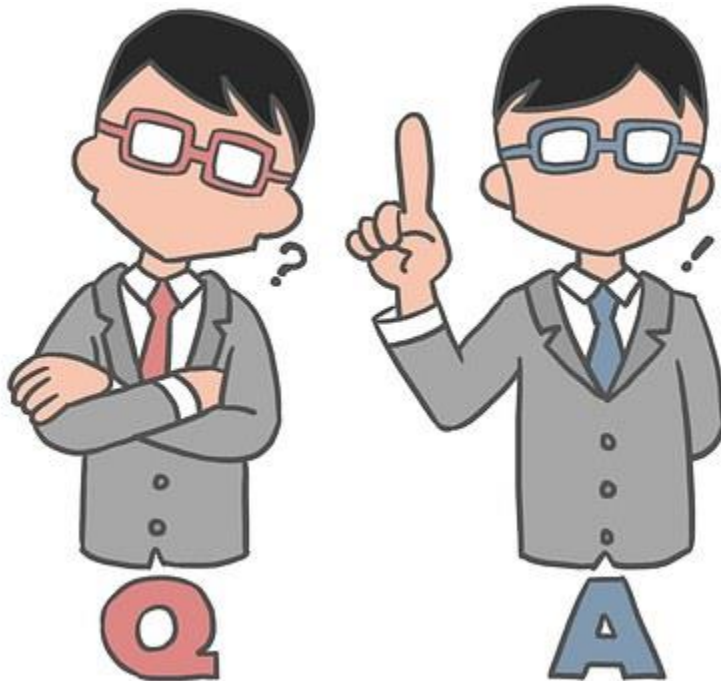
