


The Eyes of an Owl

- 1. Owls do not have eyeballs. Instead, they have eye tubes which go far back into their skulls.
- 2. Owls cannot move their eyes. They do however have the ability to rotate their necks 270 degrees to see things not directly in front of them.
- 3. Owls have huge eyes which allows lots of light to come in. This is why they have such great night vision.
- 4. Owls only see in black and white.
- 5. Owls have 3 eyelids. The upper is used for blinking, the lower for sleeping and the horizontal one for cleaning and protecting the eye.

The Ears of an Owl

Some owls have what appear to be ears on top of their head but they are only feathers. The real ears are holes that are located on the sides of the owl's head and are hidden by its feathers. An owl's face is shaped like a satellite dish, allowing it to pick up even the slightest of sounds.

The Smallest Owl in the World


The Elf Owl measures in at 5 to 6 inches tall and weighs a whopping 1.5 ounces! That's less than the weight of a candy bar!
