- 12.) Shortly after Joseph was sent to prison, 2 members of Pharaoh's staff showed up. Who were they? **His chief cupbearer and chief baker.**
- 13.) What did the chief cupbearer and the chief baker have that puzzled them while they were in prison with Joseph? **They both had dreams but didn't know what they meant.**
- 14.) Who interpreted the chief cupbearer and the chief baker's dreams? **God interpreted them through Joseph.**
- 15.) What did the chief cupbearer's dream mean? **It meant that within three days, he would be freed from the prison and become the chief cupbearer for Pharaoh once again.**
- 16.) What did the chief baker's dream mean? **It meant that within three days, he would be no more.**
