John 11:38,41-44



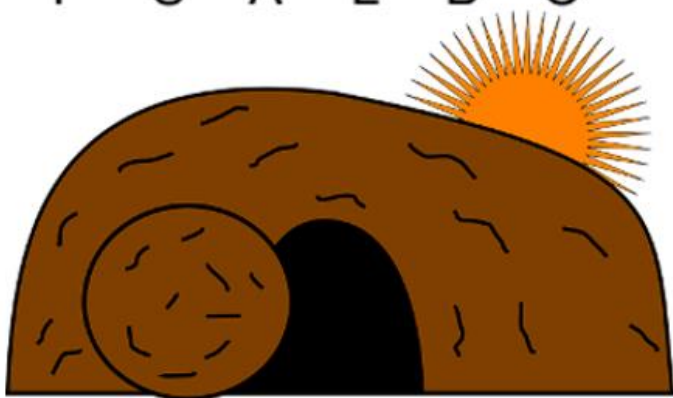
Lazarus had already been dead for 4 days when Jesus showed up at the tomb and he still brought him back to life. How do you think you would have reacted if you been there to see that miracle?

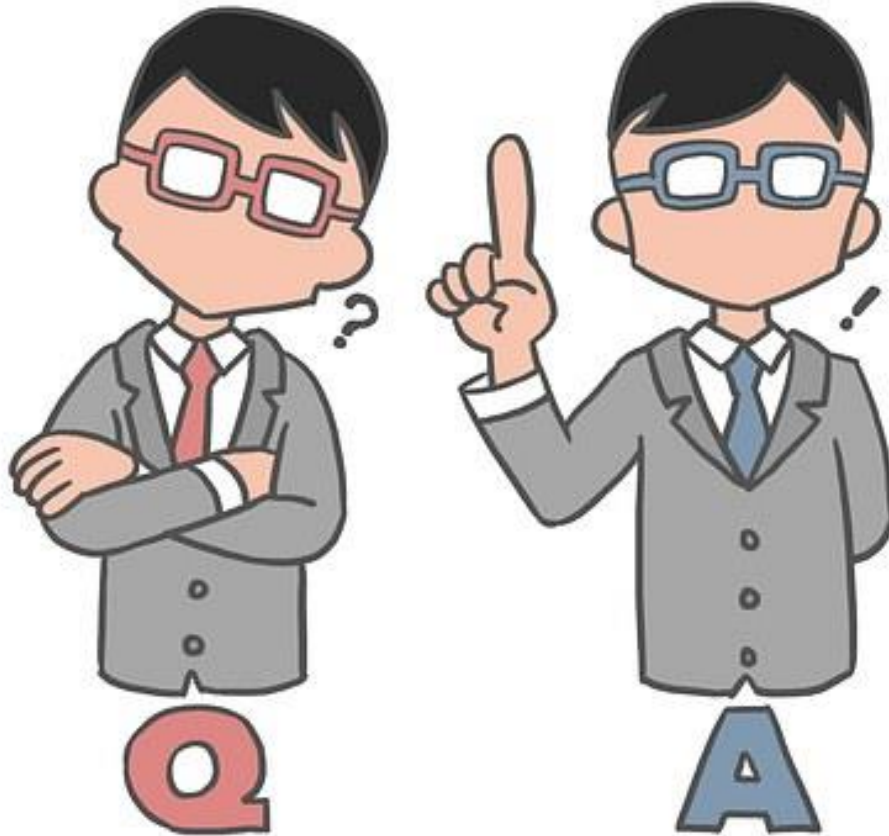

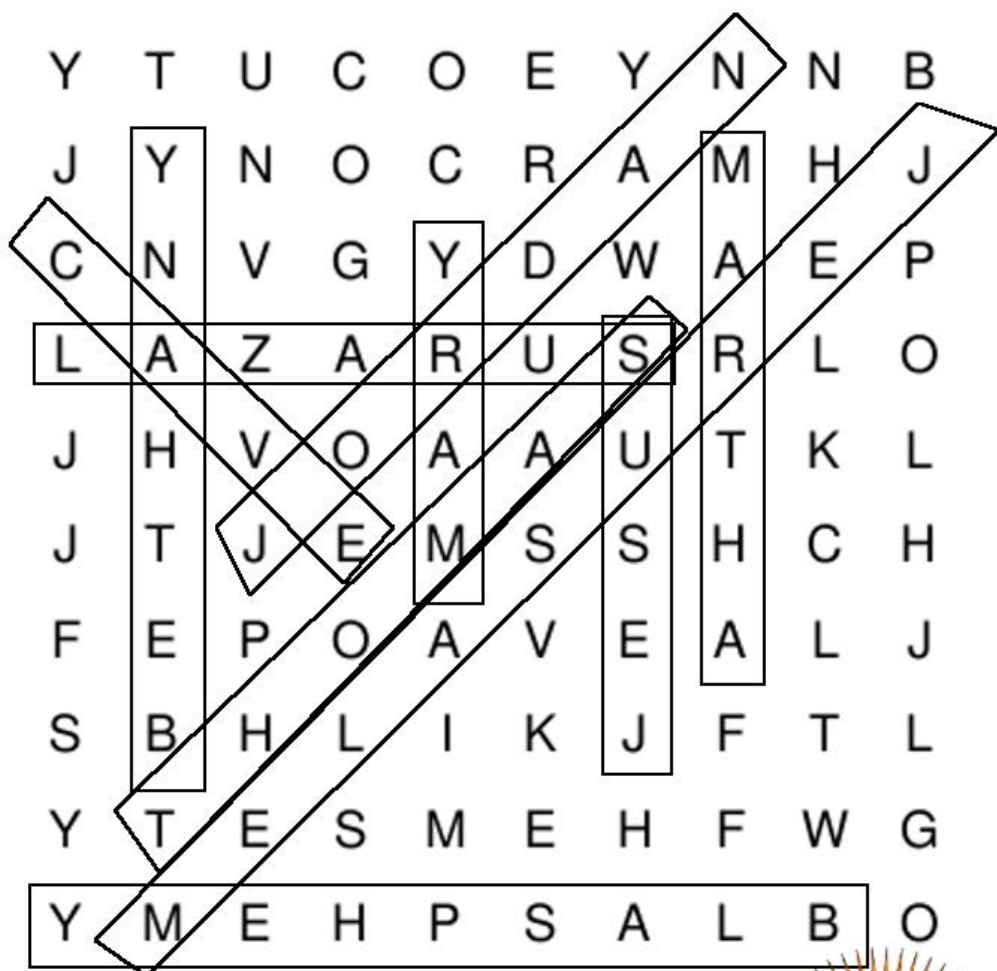

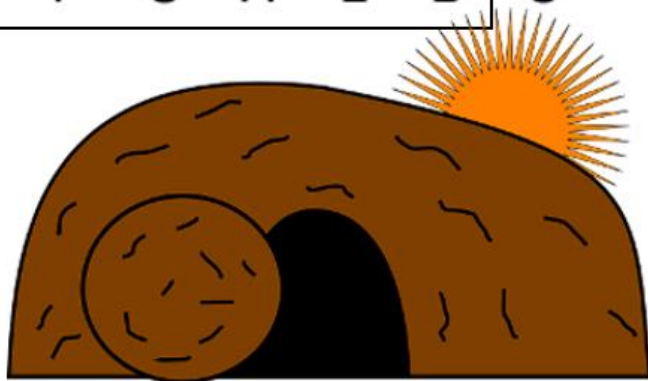
