2019 SUMTER COUNTY FAIR
YOUTH DAIRY SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors will provide feed for their animals while at the fair. Animals must be removed from the fairgrounds immediately following the end of the show and pens must be cleaned before and checked before any exhibitor receives premium money.
2. Entries will be restricted to FFA chapters and 4-H clubs and bona fide FFA members and 4-H members.
3. Registration papers on registered or grade animals must be available and presented to the Chairperson upon arrival. Only registered or grade animals will be accepted. Registration certificates must be in the name of the Exhibitor or FFA chapter showing the animal to be eligible.
4. Only polled or dehorned animals will be allowed to show.
5. All exhibitors shall be required to maintain their animals and attractive quarters throughout the show in accordance with barn rules. Any exhibitor who fails to maintain attractive and sanitary quarters can and will be penalized in the amount not to exceed total prize monies. Misconduct, misrepresentation, and/or failure to cooperate with the Dairy Show Committee in any manner will automatically forfeit any prices or premiums won by the exhibitor and the exhibitor will be eliminated from the show.
6. Each exhibitor assumes all responsibility for his/her animal in case of death, injury, or loss while at the Sumter County Fairgrounds.
7. No exhibitor shall enter more than one animal in a class.
8. There will be a limit of one animal per class and a \$25.00 entry fee.
9. Exhibitors must take thank you letters for sponsor to the fair office for receipt of awards. Thank you cards will be provided and mailed out by the Fair board.
10. Only one armband per exhibitor. Parents and guardians will **not** receive a pass. Passes can be purchase at the gate at time of check-in. Armband must be worn or you will not be able to enter the fairgrounds.

THE FAIR BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO AMEND, CHANGE, AN ADD TO ANY RULE AT ANYTIME, PROVIDED NOTICE OF SUCH AMENDMENTS, CHANGE, OR ADDITION WILL BE FURNISHED TO ALL REGISTERED EXHIBITORS. THE FINAL INTERPETATION, CONSTRUCTION, ENFORCEMENT AND INTENT OF THE RULES SHALL BE AT THE SOLE DSICRETION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SUMTER COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIAITON, INC.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Juniors: 8-10 years old by September 1, 2018

Intermediate: 11-13 years old by September 1, 2018
