RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No entry will be accepted without the doe's date of birth and the following attachment. Proof of ownership in the form of a canceled check, bill of sale, or signed statement by parent/or guardian OR a copy of the lease agreement.
2. Eligibility: Exhibitors must be members in good standing in a FFA or 4-H club/chapter and have either turned in a record book to the Sumter County 4-H office or have the completed record book with them. Must be (8) eight years old as of September 1.
3. No exhibitor may enter more than one goat for class.
4. Horned animals will be allowed provided that goat is not unruly or abusive.
5. The following are not allowed: Bucks, Pygmy, and Pygmy cross.
6. Only one armband per exhibitor. Parents and guardians will not receive a pass. Passes may be purchased at the gate at check-in. Armband must be worn you will not be able to enter the fairgrounds without it.

SHOW DAY

1. Failure to have animal under control will result in disqualification.
2. Meat goats and dairy goats are in two separate shows and shall not compete against one another.
3. Nor may a goat be shown in both shows.
4. Body clip and trimmed hooves are required.
5. Exhibitor is required to wear black pants, white shirt, closed dark shoes or boots, accompanied by official tie, jacket/vest either FFA or 4-H. No entry into the show without official dress.
6. Exhibitor should know the age of the doe and its freshening date.
7. All goats must be accompanied to the show by and official Veterinary Health Certificate listing permanent Identification stating that the following requirements have been met.
 - All animals over six months of age have been negative to an official test for Brucellosis within (90) ninety days of originated in an accredited tuberculosis free herd. The accredited herd number shall be shown on the health certificate.
 - All animals over six months of age have been negative to an official test for Brucellosis within (90) ninety days or originate in an accredited Brucellosis free herd. The accredited herd numbers should be shown on the health certificate.

JUNIOR DOE CLASSES: ANY DOE UNDER (24) TWENTY FOUR MONTHS THAT HAS NEVER BEEN FRESHENED.

- Class 1 Junior Doe Kids.....under 6 months
- Class 2 Senior Doe Kids.....6 months to under 12 months
- Class 3 Junior Doelings.....12 months to under 18 months
- Class 4 Senior Doelings.....18 months to under 24 months
