

2020 Sumter County Fair ADULT Family Living Exhibit

This Family Living Exhibit of the Sumter County Fair is open to adults of all ages. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to know the criteria specified in each exhibit class and entry category. It is also the responsibility of the exhibitor to register and follow the guidelines set forth in this document. 1. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED ON THE EXHIBIT ENTRY FORM.
2. All entries should be owned, produced, or made by the EXHIBITOR, and clearly marked with the name, and contact information on affixed entry tag.
3. **All entries must have been completed since March 1, 2019, or never before entered.**
4. All entries are submitted and exhibited at the owner's risk. While every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits, the Sumter County Fair, Family Living Exhibit volunteers, or UF/IFAS Extension Sumter County employees are not responsible for any accidental loss or damage.
5. All entries must be entered during published check in times with a *completed* entry form. **NO EARLY ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
6. **DO NOT take entries to the Fair office. These items will not be accepted, nor will we be held responsible for these items.**
7. Exhibits may be unattended during non-fair hours.
8. Exhibits must be picked up during check-out times. **DO NOT** remove exhibits early. **Unclaimed items will not be stored, nor will we be held responsible for these items.**
9. The modified Danish System of judging will be used in placing awards by oriented volunteers. The Danish System is based on a standard of quality. The judge's decision is final.

JUDGING:

Each entry will be judged according to Blue, Red, or White ribbon based on the Danish System. Every article will receive a Blue, Red or White strip ribbon. Blue is considered above average or excellent quality, Red is average quality, and White is below average quality. A First Place article will then be chosen from *each Entry* category and eligible to be considered for the Best of Show for *each Class*. Each First Place will receive a Purple Ribbon and each Best of Show will receive a Rosette Ribbon.

AWARDS:

Blue, Red or White Ribbon given to each individual item
FIRST PLACE in each *ENTRY CATEGORY* = PURPLE RIBBON
BEST OF SHOW in each *CLASS* = ROSETTE

CLASS A – BAKED GOODS

1. All exhibits must be entered on a small disposable plate in a sealed plastic bag or other disposable, clear container. Not responsible for containers.
2. Each entry must be accompanied by the recipe on a 3x5 *index card* and show all ingredients used, as well as the method of preparation.
3. *No refrigerated entries allowed.*
4. **Entire Baked Good must be entered.** (example: entire cake, not just a slice of cake)
5. Entries will be judged the day of check-in.

4. Cookies (enter SIX cookies)
5. Brownies (enter SIX brownies)
6. Homemade Candy (enter SIX pieces)

9. Other Baked Goods

CLASS AA – SAUCES/CONDIMENTS

1. All exhibits must be entered in a clear container. **Not responsible for containers.**
2. Each entry must be accompanied by the recipe on a 3x5 *index card* and show all ingredients used, as well as the method of preparation.

CLASS B – CANNING

1. Exhibit must be in a standard clear jar with new rings. **Jars should be washed, polished and labeled as to contents and date canned** - USDA guidelines must be followed.
2. *All items must be properly sealed.*
3. Each entry must be accompanied by the recipe on a 3x5 index card and show all ingredients used.
4. May enter up to **5 jars of different** varieties in each ENTRY category.

1. May enter up to **5 different** items in each ENTRY category.

CLASS E – SPECIALTY NEEDLEWORK

1. May enter up to **5 different** items in each ENTRY category.

CLASS EE-QUILTING

1. Quilts may be appliquéd, pieced, embroidered, or a combination of quilting techniques. The quilts may be by an individual, two people, or a group of three or more.
2. A quilt by an individual must have been pieced, quilted (either by hand or machine), and finished by an individual. A two-person quilt is one that two people work on in the construction or finishing in any way. This includes quilting done for hire. A group quilt is one created by three or more people.
3. Hand quilting is to be entered in this category, quilting must be done by the person (or persons) entering the quilt.
4. Machine quilting – entry form must reflect whether the quilting was done on a longarm machine (quilting by hire) or a regular sewing machine.

33. Wearable Art (All garment entries must consist of three layers and include quilting)
34. Miniature (under 34 7/8 inches on longest side)
35. Small Quilt (over 35 inches on longest side but not over 59 7/8 inches)
36. Medium Quilt (over 60 inches on longest side but not over 79 7/8 inches)
37. Large Quilt (over 80 inches on longest side)
38. T-Shirt Quilts
39. Quilts from Kits

CLASS F – CLOTHING

1. Entries *Must* be created by exhibitor and handmade.
2. All entries should be pressed and clean.
3. No lingerie or undergarments.
4. All entries should be submitted on a WIRE HANGER (use clothespins as necessary to secure).
5. May enter up to **2 different** items in each ENTRY category.
