2020 SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION YOUTH MEAT GOAT SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

PURPOSE:

THE INTENT AND PURPOSE OF THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION YOUTH MEAT GOAT SHOW IS TO PROVIDE A MEANS TO PROMOTE THE ANIMAL INDUSTRY IN FLORIDA. FURTHERMORE, THIS IS AN EDUCATIONAL PROJECT FOR YOUTH IN FLORIDA AND SHOWING PROVIDES YOUTH WITH A MEANS TO GAIN RECOGNITION FOR ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE MEAT GOAT PROJECT.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. ONLY A BONA-FIDE 4-H OR FFA MEMBER, WHO IS AT LEAST 8 YEARS OF AGE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1ST AND IS ENROLLED IN A FLORIDA RECOGNIZED SCHOOL. YOUTH MUST NOT HAVE COMPLETED THE 12TH GRADE.
2. EXHIBITOR MUST SHOW AS A MEMBER OF THE SAME ORGANIZATION HE/SHE ENTERED.
3. EACH EXHIBITOR/OWNER MUST ASSUME ALL LIABILITY IN CASE OF DEATH OR INJURY TO HIS/HER ANIMAL AND ANY INJURY OR DEATH INCURRED BY HIS/HER ANIMAL.
4. THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION AND/OR ITS DIRECTORS WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY INJURY OR LOSS TO HUMAN, ANIMAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.
5. ANIMALS THAT CANNOT BE HANDLED PROPERLY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
6. GOATS MUST BE IN SHOW SHAPE UPON ARRIVAL AT THE FAIR.

ENTRIES:

1. NO EXHIBITOR MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONE GOAT PER CLASS.
2. **THE FEE FOR OUT OF COUNTY EXHIBITOR IS \$30.00 ENTRY FEE FOR FIRST ANIMAL AND \$20.00 THEREAFTER PER ADDITIONAL ANIMAL PER EXHIBITOR. THERE IS A \$10.00 FEE FOR SHOWMANSHIP. CHECKS NEED TO BE PAYABLE TO THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION.**
3. **THE FEE FOR IN-COUNTY EXHIBITOR IS \$25.00 ENTRY FEE FOR THE FIRST ANIMAL AND \$15.00 THEREAFTER PER ADDITIONAL ANIMAL PER EXHIBITOR. THERE IS A \$10.00 FEE FOR SHOWMANSHIP. CHECKS NEED TO BE PAYABLE TO THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION.**
4. USE A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH EXHIBITOR
5. ALL INFORMATION AND SIGNATURES MUST BE COMPLETED ON ENTRY FORM.
6. ENTRIES MUST BE ON OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY **FEBRUARY 28, 2020** ALONG WITH ENTRY FEE.
7. ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK-IN. HOWEVER, A \$15.00 LATE FEE WILL BE APPLIED TO THE APPLICATION.
8. **CASH ONLY ENTRY FEES ACCEPTED THE DAY OF SHOW.**
9. EACH ANIMAL ENTERED IN THE SHOW MUST HAVE THE CORRECT BIRTH DATE ON THEIR ENTRY FORM.
10. ANIMALS MUST BE SHOWN IN THEIR RESPECTIVE DIVISION AND AGE CLASSES. EXHIBITOR THAT HAVE BEEN INCORRECTLY ENTERED MAY, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE, BE TRANSFERRED TO THEIR PROPER DIVISION/CLASSES PRIOR TO JUDGING.

HEALTH REGULATIONS:

1. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE, PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION AND FREE OF EVIDENCE OF DISEASE. ALSO, MUST HAVE OFFICIAL USDA SCRAPIE EAR TAG, WILL BE INSPECTED UPON ARRIVAL.
2. NO VET CHECK AT THE SHOW.

GENERAL:

1. THE OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CARE AND CLEAN-UP OF HIS/HER OWN ANIMALS. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR STALL AREAS CLEAN BEFORE LEAVING THE GROUNDS. IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PREMIUM MONEY, THE STALLS MUST BE CHECKED OUT BY THE BARN SUPERINTENDENT.
2. DUE TO THE EXCESSIVE DEMAND ON THE ELECTRICAL OUTLETS, GENERATORS ARE WELCOMED.
3. EXHIBITORS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THEIR ANIMAL UPON ENTERING THE FAIRGROUNDS.

4. ALL ANIMALS SHOULD BE RESTRICTED ON HALTER AND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THEIR EXHIBITORS BEFORE AND AFTER THE SHOW.
5. ANIMALS THAT CAN NOT BE CONTROLLED OR HANDLED PROPERLY BY THE EXHIBITOR WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND DISQUALIFIED.
6. EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO WEAR BLACK PANTS, WHITE SHIRTS, CLOSED TOED DARK SHOES OR BOOTS, ACCOMPANIED BY OFFICIAL TIE, JACKET/VEST EITHER 4-H OR FFA. NO ENTRY INTO THE SHOW WITHOUT OFFICIAL DRESS.
7. ONLY ONE ENTRY ARMBAND FOR EXHIBITOR. PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WILL NOT RECEIVE A PASS. PASSES CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE GATE AT TIME OF CHECK-IN.

JUDGING/PREMIUMS:

1. THE SHOW WILL BE JUDGED ACCORDING TO THE MODIFIED DANISH SYSTEM BASED ON THE INDIVIDUAL BREED STANDARDS OF EACH ANIMAL.
2. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DIVIDE OR COMBINE CLASSES BASED ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES.
4. ALL PREMIUM MONIES WILL BE PAID TO THE EXHIBITOR DESIGNATED ON THE ENTRY FORM.
5. PREMIUM MONIES WILL BE PAID TO THE YOUTH AFTER THEIR PENS HAS BEEN DESIGNATED CLEAN BY A SHOW COMMITTEE MEMBER, AND GIVEN PERMISSION TO CHECK-OUT BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT.

SHOWMANSHIP: AGE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2019

1. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW THEIR OWN ANIMAL.
2. ALL SHOWMANSHIP ANIMALS MUST BE ENTERED IN A JUDGED CLASS.
3. JUNIOR 8 YEARS OLD – 10 YEARS OLD
4. INTERMEDIATE 11 YEARS OLD – 13 YEARS OLD
5. SENIOR 14 YEARS OLD – 18 YEARS OLD

RULES:

1. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE DOE'S DATE OF BIRTH AND THE FOLLOWING ATTACHMENT. PROOF OF OWNERSHIP IN THE FORM OF A CANCELED CHECK, BILL OF SALE, OR SIGNED STATEMENT BY PARENT/GUARDIAN OR A COPY OF LEASE AGREEMENT.
2. HORNED ANIMALS WILL BE ALLOWED PROVIDED THE GOAT IS NOT UNRULEY OR ABUSIVE.
3. THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED: BUCKS, PYGMY, AND PYGMY CROSS.
4. MEAT GOATS AND DAIRY GOATS ARE IN TWO SEPARATE SHOWS AND SHALL NOT COMPETE AGAINST ONE ANOTHER EXCEPT WITH SHOWMANSHIP.
5. NOR MAY A GOAT BE SHOWN IN BOTH SHOWS.
6. GOAT MUST BE BODY CLIPPED AND TRIMMED HOOVES.
7. WETHERS WILL BE SHOWN IN ONE OF THREE WEIGHT CLASSES. GOAT WILL BE WEIGHED AT CHECK IN.

YOUTH MEAT DOE CLASSES

CLASSES:

1. CLASS 1 DOELINGS – 12 MONTHS AND UNDER
2. CLASS 2 JUNIOR DOES – 13 MONTHS – 23 MONTHS
3. CLASS 3 SENIOR DOES – OVER 24 MONTHS
