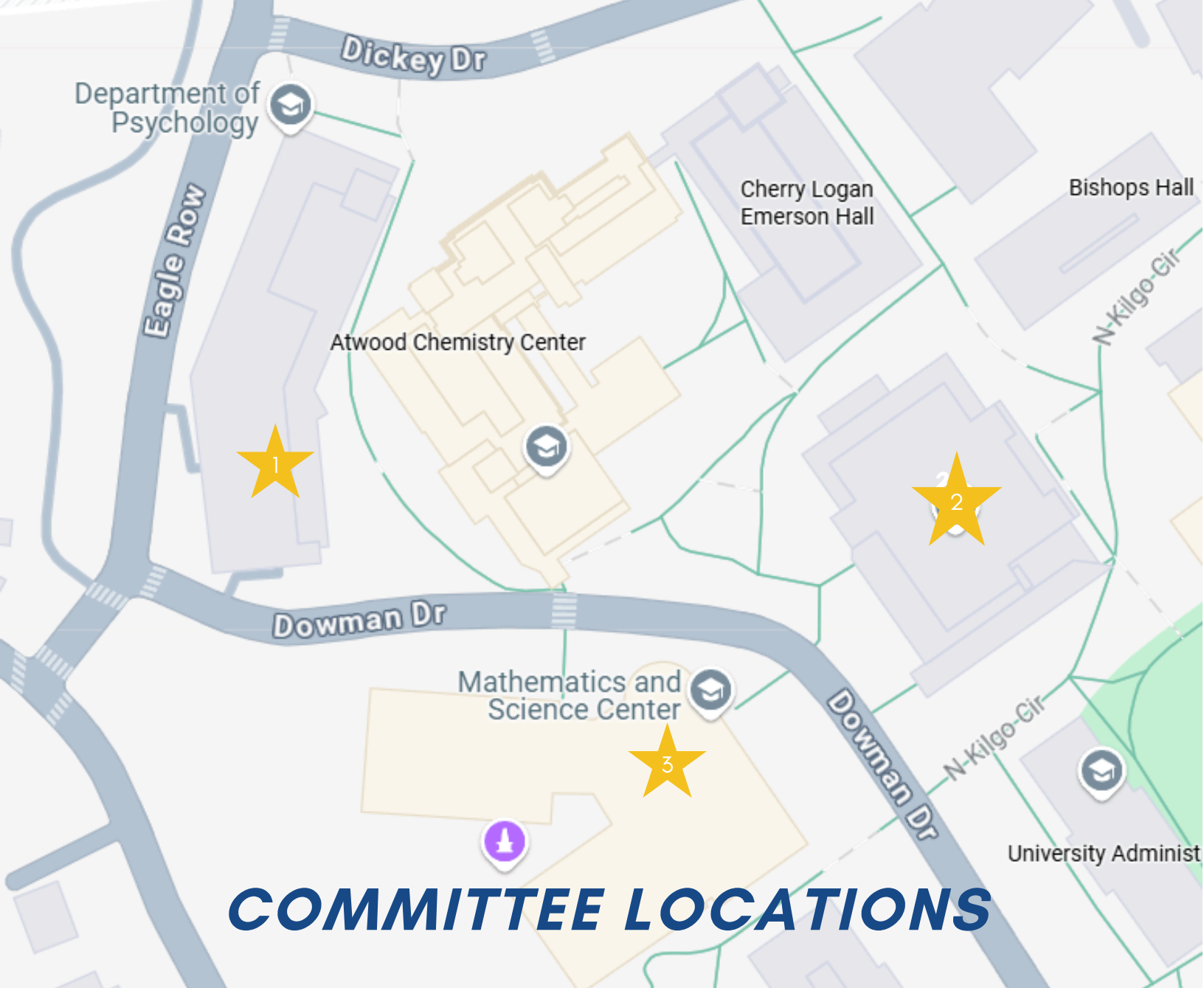

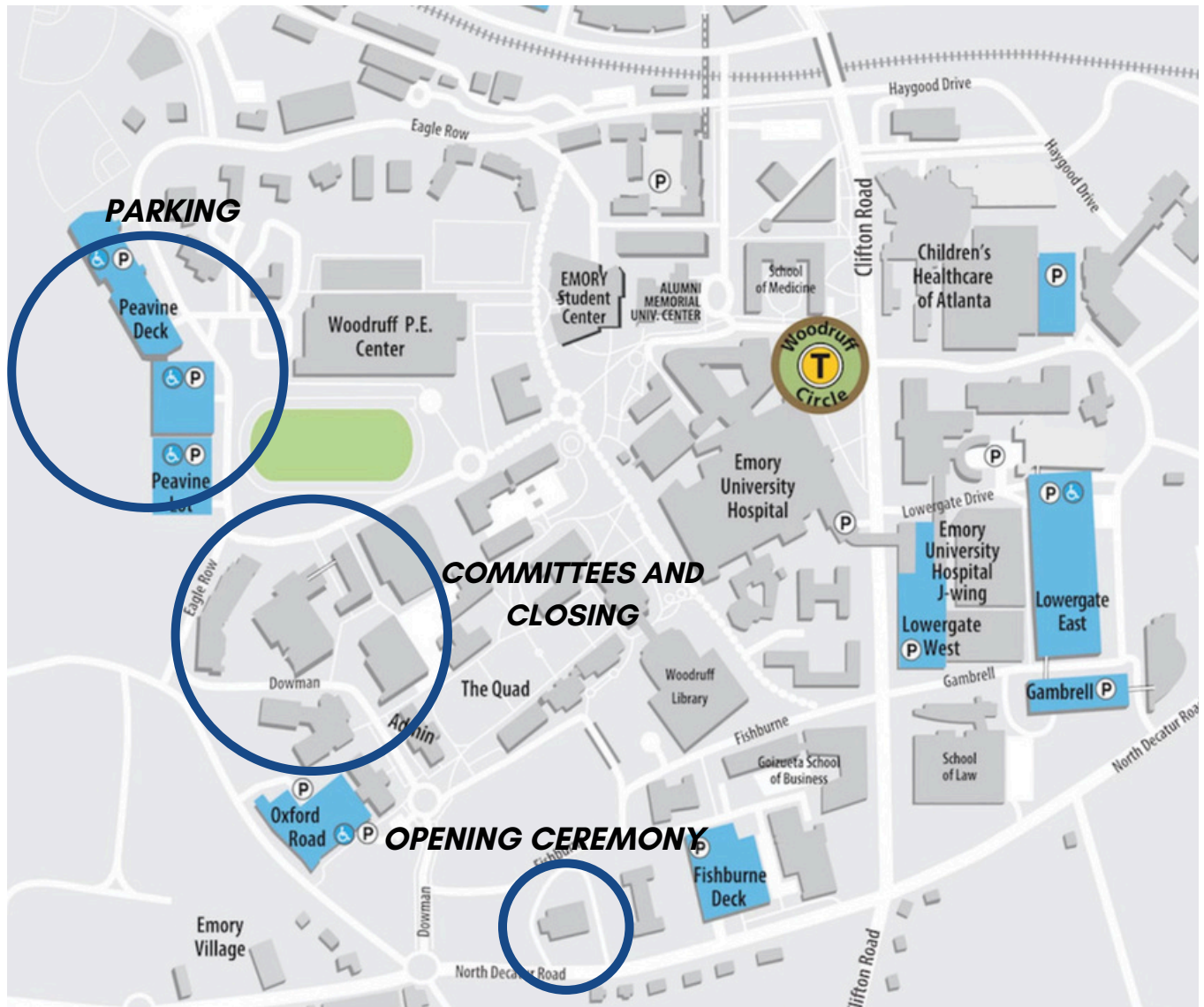

Parking Information (Blue buildings are parking decks)

For personal vehicles parking (including overnight), there will be available parking in the Peavine Parking Deck, Gambrell Parking Deck, and the Fishburne Parking Deck. It is free on weekends and available after 4PM on weekdays. On weekdays before 4PM there is an open-air visitor parking lot next to the Peavine Parking Deck. You will be able to park there at the following hourly rates:

- 0-15 minutes: Free**
- 15 minutes - 1 hour: \$6**
- 1-2 hours: \$8**
- 2-3 hours: \$10**
- 3-4 hours: \$12**
- 4-24 hours: \$14**

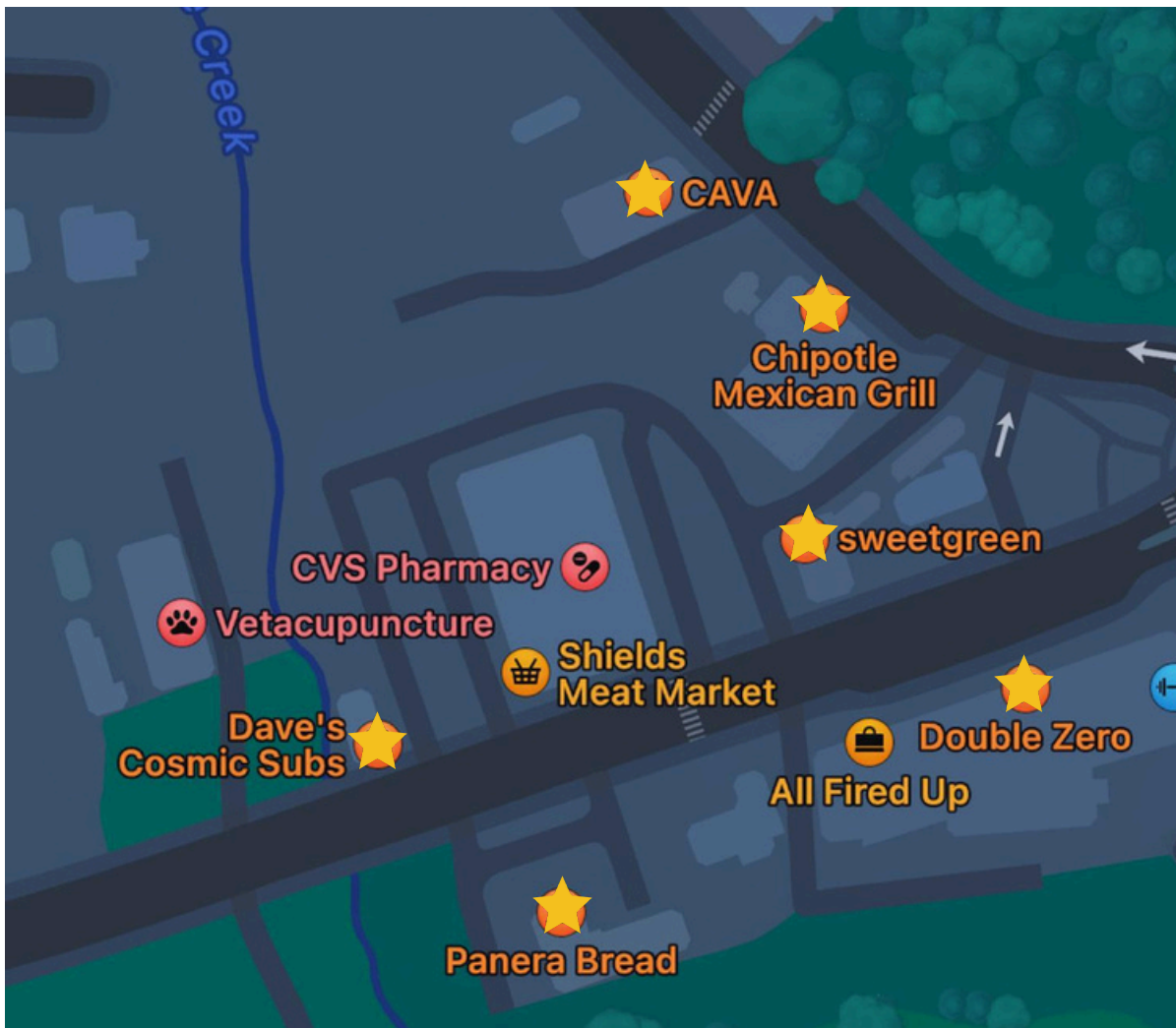

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **Plagiarism:** Delegates should not engage in plagiarism of any form, and all ideas written in position papers, directives, and resolutions during committee should be a product of the delegate's own work. This includes not pre-writing resolutions or directives outside of committee, and not using AI to write papers for this conference.
2. **Dress Code:** The dress code at ENMUNC is formal attire. Delegates are expected to wear Western Business Attire.
3. **Respect:** Delegates should treat each other with respect. Discrimination, bullying, and harassment will not be tolerated. Delegates should not engage in racism, sexism, homophobia, xenophobia, or any other form of discrimination, under any circumstances.
4. **Technology Policy:** Delegates should not use their cell phones during committee. Laptops are only allowed in General Assembly committees during unmoderated caucuses for writing resolutions, and delegates should not be typing outside of this time. Crisis committees are technology-free (bring a pen to write with!). Delegates should not use AI services like ChatGPT.
5. All delegates under the age of 18 should be accompanied by a teacher, guardian, parent, faculty sponsor, or trusted adult during the duration of the conference, while on the campus of Emory University.

FURTHER REMINDERS

1. Delegates must adhere to not only the ENMUNC VI Code of Conduct, but also follow all policies set by the Emory University Code of Conduct. This includes Emory's no-tolerance policy for smoking, the illegal consumption of drugs and alcohol, and the honor code. The Emory Code of Conduct also includes provisions regarding harassment and violence.
2. Advisors must send the ENMUNC Secretariat the liability waiver and media release form prior to participation in ENMUNC VI. Advisors must also join the ENMUNC VI advisors GroupMe.
3. Advisors must also join the ENMUNC VI advisors GroupMe. This will be the fastest way to reach members of secretariat during the hours of the conference.
4. Reporting Forms will be available in each committee room. These forms should be used for reporting activity that does not follow the ENMUNC VI Code of Conduct, the Emory Code of Conduct, or otherwise unacceptable behavior from anyone involved in ENMUNC VI.
5. Optional lunches are available directly through ENMUNC VI. If you would like to order lunch for Saturday, March 28, fill out the form sent to your school's email by March 19.
6. Due to new policies set by Emory University, only Emory University students are able to scan into buildings. We will have one primary entrance for each committee building which has a staffer or prop to keep the door open. **Please only use the primary entrances on the following page.** All are most accessible via Dowman Drive.
