Therefore, we have decided this year to run a Christmas Card Competition to allow some talent out there to help us create a fab card. The winner/s will win a mini poster of their design and a Gift Voucher for a 2-hour session at the studio worth up to £28.00. No Age restrictions.

There are a few rules:

1. OBJECTIVE: Create an original festive card. You are welcome to copy any of our Characters for your card. Think about the stuff of Christmas such as Trees, Lights, snow etc.
2. DIMENSIONS: The size of your picture needs to be A4 either landscape or portrait. All characters, objects on the design need to have been outlined in black to help with publishing and printing. Please use felt pens, paint or create on a digital format in a PNG or JPEG format. Please do not use pencil crayons to colour in as these are not strong enough for publishing.
3. ENTRIES DEADLINE & FORMAT: Please email to the studio to ginger@sparkyink.co.uk with the heading Christmas Card Comp 2022 for digital designs in a PNG/JPEG format OR scan your picture in if paper-based and create either a PDF/PNG/JPEG. You can also drop your pictures in at the Studio on a Monday, Wednesday or Thursday. If posting outside the hours of 10 and 4pm, the post-box is on the door on the Left next to our Studio door. 4. IMPORTANT: The closing date is 31st October 2022 for all entries. Please ensure you put a piece of paper in with your details on: Name, Age, Contact details so we can contact you.
5. T's and C's: All work must be original. By entering the Competition you are allowing the Studio to use your work for Free as a Greetings Card. The Studio will not profit on your work although we may sell the cards to raise money for charity after printing costs. We may reprint the cards again in the future. Again these will not be used for profit.
