Clothed By Faith Inc.

Mission: The Closets for Schools program install and maintain clothing closets in area schools. This program was developed to give schools immediate access to clothing for students. The closet is put in a school with space for clothing for at least 120 students. The closet is used by multiple schools in the same high school feeder pattern. Each student will receive four uniform shirts, two uniform bottoms, new underwear & socks and a pair of shoes. Each student served is documented by school personnel.

Clothed by Faith plans to open five new closets in 2022 and to restock the three established closets.

God's Garden

Mission: Gods Garden became a 501(c)3 non-profit in 2016. The goal is to keep providing organic vegetables free of charge, to increase gardening knowledge in the community, promote healthy eating and food security, to reduce the food insecurity effect, and to increase yields by improving the soil with manure and gypsum. This garden provides a viable means of bringing fresh organic vegetables to those most in need in the local area and to inspire them to make their own gardens. The garden produces an abundance of fresh vegetables which we share with several local food pantries: E. Ft. Bend Human Needs Ministry, Second Mile, Rosenberg-Richmond Helping Hands, Inc. and Trini's Corner Market (Mamie George Community Center, Catholic Charities). We also provided vegetables to Ft. Bend Women's Center, Afghan refugees, and CPS children without placement. In 2021 we provided 17,447 pounds to the food pantries. The vision also includes being an education resource for teaching and sharing knowledge we have gained over the past 22 years or more, helping young people attain community service hours, bringing the local community together, establishing a kid's garden, etc. All of this results in touching lives and making a difference.

Mission: GiGi's University (GiGi U) is an innovative vocational training program designed for individuals with Down syndrome to learn foundational skills to prepare them for a job in the community and a life of confidence and independence. This program's goal is to encourage and involve individuals with disabilities in the workforce and provide equal economic opportunity for these individuals to be contributing members of our local community. GiGi U positively impacts the lives of individuals and employers by increasing the number of teens and adults with disabilities who are employable. The program is offered free of charge and focuses on the development of career skills, financial literacy, communication skills and lifelong wellness. Students learn communication, interviewing, money management, customer service, public speaking, fine motor, team building, and wellness skills, utilizing teaching methods that are tailored to the unique learning style of individuals with Down syndrome.

Mission: Texana's new Center for Advancement focuses on meeting the needs of transition aged youth (14-25) with autism and intellectual disabilities, a population who historically have been underserved. As clients age out of the public school system, many graduate onto Mom and Dad's couch. Youth with autism and intellectual disabilities are often capable of a greater degree of independence and competitive employment, but the transition to paid work and changing living situations is difficult to navigate without a map.
