HAPPY HOLIDAYS TO ALL!!


- I hope you all had a pleasant Thanksgiving. Ours quiet, but nice. We even took a nice walk outside.



game. UPDATE: due to COVID and the numbers going up, it was decided to cancel December's meeting. -Christine asked for input on what we want to do at quilt guild meetings.


